KHAFRE bumped with a rival at the start, brushed with another foe early while going to the front, showed the way in the two path while in hand, controlled the action through the far turn, responded well when set down after turning into the stretch, came under a right-handed crop inside the three-sixteenths pole, drew off under the crop until outside the sixteenth-pole then was placed under a hand-ride and was eased in the final sixteenth while much the best. O P FIRECRACKER was hustled from the gate, saved ground while well placed just off the pace, chased inside on the far turn, was driven into the stretch in the two path, proved no match for the winner in the drive, fought with two foes for the place and narrowly earned that position. CENTAVO was hustled from the start, raced in the three path on the first turn, settled on the outside, was asked late on the backstretch, chased in the four path on the far turn, battled outside of two rivals for the place in the stretch and just missed that position while clear for the show. RETAIL MAN was hustled from the gate, rounded the first turn in the three path, stalked the pace on the outside, chased in the three path on the far turn, battled between foes for the minor awards in the stretch and weakened but just held the last spot in the superfecta. ALLABOUTTHEMONEY was hustled from the gate, raced in the four path on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved in late on the backstretch then came under urging, dropped from the two path to the rail early on the far turn, saved ground into the stretch and lacked the needed response. COMMANDPERFORMANCE bumped with a rival at the start, checked while pinched back between horses early, traveled around the first turn in the three path, was urged along near the rear on the backstretch, went around the far turn in the three path, spun into the stretch in the four path and failed to respond. LORD CAPTAIN settled on the inside, was urged along passing the five-eighths pole, saved ground through the far turn and also failed to respond.

NILO'S ROSE coaxed from the gate, showed the way five paths off the inside briefly until able to clear rivals and tuck to the two path, showed the way in hand just off the inside, tucked inside into the turn and came under increasing pressure from TWIRLING BEAUTY knocking heads with that rival from the seven-sixteenths through to the quarter pole, spun just of the inside into upper stretch shaking off that rival confronted by the runner up, came under cross reined encouragement a furlong out, drifted out herding her main danger three paths before gamely repelling the challenge late to inch away to the wire. ARMY GAL coaxed from the start, chased two then three wide coming under urging at the five-sixteenths, angled four wide into upper stretch, rallied to latch on near the eighth pole, dug in under a drive threatening through to the finish, got herded out three paths from the furlong ground to inside the sixteenth marker, then got rebuffed in the late stages while clear for the place honors. ALLENHURST chased just off the inside under a ride from the seven-sixteenths, tipped three wide into upper stretch, and kept on to the finish. BRILAND bobbled at the break, chased three wide under encouragement from the three-eighths, angled four to five wide into upper stretch and kept on to the wire. FORTUNA MIA broke out at the start forcing TWIRLING BEAUTY to steady, chased along the inside under urging from the seven-sixteenths, angled three to four wide for home and weakened in the stretch. TWIRLING BEAUTY broke a half a beat slow and was forced to steady at the start when FORTUNA MIA broke outwards taking over her lane, tipped out four to five wide and pulled on the bit advancing into prominence with nine-sixteenths to go, continued to range up and tucked to the two path inside the half mile pole before engaging the leader in head to head combat with seven-sixteenths remaining, came under urging nearing the quarter pole and swung three wide into upper stretch, got shaken off straightened away and tired.

SCHLOMO was hustled to the front, set the pace under pressure to his outside, vied inside STEWIE while along the rail on the turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, dueled with the aforementioned rival in the stretch and gamely prevailed under strong urging. STEWIE was hustled from the gate, pressed the pace on the outside, drew even with the leader inside the nine-sixteenths pole, vied outside of SCHLOMO while in the two path on the turn, was given his cue near the quarter-pole, dueled outside of the aforementioned opponent in the stretch, fought gamely to the finish and was denied while able to get the place. RUNANDSCORE was hustled from the gate then urged along on the outside, dropped from the four path to the two path early on the turn, spun into the stretch in the three path then moved a bit further out, found his best stride in the final furlong and finished with good energy but was too late while able to get the show. WARALO unseated the rider and ran loose in the warm-up for about a quarter-mile before being apprehended by an outrider, was brought back behind the gate while remaining weightless in the saddle for a few minutes then was deemed fit to run by the state veterinarian, broke in and bumped with an opponent, moved out while urged along near the back, dropped from the three path to the rail early on the turn, saved ground from that point into the stretch, gained under a drive in the stretch but flattened out some late and lacked the needed kick. ON THE HILL dropped back while urged along, steadied along the rail early on the turn, moved to the three path late on that bend and improved position then drifted out late. THANK YOU JON broke a half-step slow while last to commence then was hustled, tracked the leading duo on the outside, chased those foes in the three path on the turn, dropped back into upper stretch and weakened. MESSI THE MAGICIAN bumped with a rival at the start and was off a half-step slow, was urged along towards the rear, moved from the rail to the three path early on the turn, spun into the stretch in the four path and was no factor.

LAURELIN (IRE) brushed the off side stall at the start, raced along the inside through the first turn near the tail of the field, tipped out three wide and advanced down the backstretch to be just off the top pair with half a mile to go, tucked to the rail briefly into the far turn and came under light coaxing to advance inside and then tipped back to the two path with five-sixteenths to go, spun just off the inside into upper stretch set down for the drive, rallied to collar the leader a furlong out, came inwards to look that rival in the eye through the final sixteenth and gamely prevailed on the wire. ROOFER bumped with a rival at the start then was hustled, moved up to get the lead outside the half-mile pole, went clear leaving the backstretch, drew away in the two path on the turn, came under the crop in upper stretch, remained well clear passing the eighth-pole, shortened stride in the final furlong and was caught late while clear for the place. MOTEL PATEL broke fast then was hustled, led early then lost the advantage to the runner-up late on the backstretch, dropped back into the turn, moved from the rail to the three path going around that bend, turned into upper stretch under a drive, kept on in

pursuit of the top two in the stretch and lacked the needed kick while able to safely secure the show. TOGA DAN climbed significantly while urged along on the backstretch, went around the turn in the four path and improved position to get the last spot in the superfecta. NO PROBLEM broke a half-step slow, angled in under urging early, raced in the two path on the turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and lacked the needed response. ARCH'S ASSAULT was urged along on the outside, traveled around the turn in the five then six path and failed to respond. EIGHTY GOLD was bumped on both sides at the start and off a step slow then taken up, was urged along while racing with his head held high, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. DISCO DERVISH was fractious behind the gate and reluctant to load, dropped back while urged along, rounded the turn in the two path, turned into the stretch in the four path and showed little.
