ICE ROAD was urged along towards the rear, went three then four wide on the turn, gained six wide into upper stretch, rallied outside into the final furlong and closed strongly to get up late. YORK TAVERN was hustled from the gate, chased the pace on the outside then in the four path on the turn, made a bid in the five path at the quarter-pole then took the lead in upper stretch, drifted out some near the furlong marker, led under a drive into the final sixteenth but was caught while clear for the place. WINE RESPONSIBLY was off slow and spotted the front a few lengths, angled in near the three-quarter pole, was urged along off the pace, went around the turn in the two then three path, was driven into the stretch in the four path, remained on his inside lead until near the sixteenth-pole then swapped to the proper lead and finished willingly for the show. DEPUTY CONNECT was urged along near the back on the outside, rounded the turn in the five path, spun into upper stretch in the seven path, chased into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick. GOLDEN PURCHASE was hustled to the front then angled in, showed the way under some pressure, was urged along in the two path on the turn, lost the lead outside the quarter-pole and gave way. ASSERTIVE ATTITUDE moved out leaving the chute then tracked the pace, made a bid in the three path on the turn, took the lead under urging approaching the quarter-pole, lost the advantage in upper stretch, dropped back into the final furlong and tired. SCOTTO dropped well back while showing no speed, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. MAJESTIC ARC pressed the pace on the inside, dropped back along the rail near the five-sixteenths pole and faded.

WILD IRIS got bumped at the start by THAT'STHEFACTJACK, chased five then four wide coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled out six to seven wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and dueled through the final furlong with the runner up and just got the nod on the wire. SHE'S WICKED SMART coaxed from the gate, chased four then three wide patiently handled, took over command swinging five wide into upper stretch and was set down straightened away, dug in under lone threat and dueled through the final eighth to the finish and just lost the bob on the line while well clear of the rest. CORRI FELICE showed the way in hand just off the inside coming under coaxing near the five-sixteenths, yielded the front continuing just off the inside into upper stretch, weakened in the drive while along safely for the show honors. LUCKY AND GORGEOUS coaxed from the start, chased just off the inside under a ride from three furlongs out, angled five wide into upper stretch, improved position to the finish. MILLIE JEAN coaxed from the gate, chased three then two wide, came under coaxing tucked inside at the three-eighths, angled out five wide into upper stretch and weakened. COLETTE'S JOY got bumped at the start by EDDIES ROCKET, who lunged inwards at the break, chased just off the inside and then along the inside, tipped to the two path placed to coaxing when the aforementioned foe took to the rail in front, angled out five wide into upper stretch and tired, then got pulled up after the finish and was subsequently transported off the course via equine ambulance. THAT'STHEFACTJACK broke out a step at the start bumping WILD IRIS, chased three wide under encouragement from the three-eighths, angled six to seven wide at the head of the stretch and tired. JENAS MERCY took the overland route five to six paths off the inside down the backstretch and then five wide through the turn, went eight wide at the top of the stretch and made no impact. EDDIES ROCKET fractious in the gate prior to the start, lunged inwards at the start bumping COLETTE'S JOY, chased along the inside down the backstretch, tipped two then three wide placed to urging at the seven-sixteenths, swung four wide into upper stretch and trailed throughout.

AUTUMN EVENING was hustled from the gate, stalked the pace on the backstretch, chased in the three path on the turn, made a bid at the quarter-pole, dueled outside of the runner-up in the stretch, brushed with that foe late and narrowly prevailed. SWEETEST PRINCESS pressed then tracked the pace, engaged the leader in the two path on the turn, took the advantage just inside the three-eighths pole, dueled inside of the winner in the stretch, drifted out some inside the furlong marker, brushed with the aforementioned rival late and was denied while clear for the place. NATURE'S CANDY settled off the pace, shifted from the rail to the two path early on the turn then chased, moved out outside the furlong marker and willingly earned the show. WILLOW BEND bumped with a rival at the start, tracked the pace between horses, dropped back outside the five-eighths pole, went three to four wide on the turn and lacked the needed kick. MS. TART broke in and bumped with a rival, settled on the outside, dropped back outside the five-eighths pole, was urged four to five wide on the turn and lacked the needed response. MIDTOWN LIGHTS went to the front, set the pace under pressure, moved clear outside the five-eighths pole, was challenged while inside on the turn, lost the advantage just inside the three-eighths pole and tired. LUNA MOTH was urged along at the rear, rounded the turn in the two path, moved out into upper stretch and was no factor.

LAST GLORY was well placed down the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, moved to the two path late on that bend, came out into upper stretch, gained while remaining on her inside lead, swapped to the proper lead while taking the advantage outside the furlong marker and edged clear under strong urging to prevail. LADY ARWEN settled off the pace, moved from the rail to the three path on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and earned the place while no match for the winner. VIOLETS SMILE was fractious in the gate, went to the front then moved in while showing the way, lost the lead leaving the backstretch, vied in the two path on the turn, battled under a drive into the final furlong and weakened while just able to get the show. ALLEY'S SONG tracked the pace on the outside, took the lead leaving the backstretch, vied in the three path on the turn, lost the lead in upper stretch and tired. BEWILDERED went two to three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. BIG HAZEL went two to three wide on the turn and was no factor. MAGIC EIGHT BALL was fractious in the gate, took an awkward stride after the start and steadied, moved up on the outside, chased in the four path on the turn and came

up empty. PERMED was hard ridden near the back, moved out while climbing outside the five-eighths pole, went around the turn in the five path, turned into the stretch in the six path and was no factor. ACCELERINA was forwardly placed then dropped back under urging late on the backstretch, went three to four wide on the turn and had nothing left. RAININGATTHEBEACH lugged out at the rear, continued to lug out in the three path on the turn, came out into upper stretch and faltered then was transported off the track via equine ambulance.
