COACH OF THE YEAR was reserved early and was guided towards the inside, eased off the inside on the far turn and swung out six wide leaving the turn and finished well on the outside to gain the place award while no match to the winner. KULEANA was well rated early towards the inside, continued on tracking the leaders and raced on the inside to the two path on the far turn, swung out four wide leaving the turn to make a bid nearing the furlong marker but flattened out losing the place award while besting the rest.
