ATARA was with the pace early from between rivals then went up to press BLAME THE BANKER two wide by the half mile marker and on the far turn, made a four wide bid leaving the turn and bumped with HELEN'S REVENGE nearing the furlong marker while on even terms for command and then kicked clear by the sixteenth marker and remained clear to the wire to prove best. SAILAWAY was well rated along the inside and remained on the rail to the quarter pole and swung out six wide and finished well late gaining the place award on the wire. HELEN'S REVENGE prompted the pace from the outside and then stalked the leaders while three to four wide on the turn, made a five wide bid leaving the turn to go on even terms for command with the winner and bumping with that rival nearing the furlong marker but flattened out late while losing the place award on the wire. LOOKS FIRST was rank and hard to handle from the kick back down the backside, also hard to handle till finally settling down leaving the half mile marker and was two to three wide on the turn, swung out widest leaving the bend but offered no rally. BLAME THE BANKER set a pressured pace on the inside and came up empty the final quarter of a mile.

PINKY BRIER coaxed from the gate, cut the pace just off the inside and then along the inside under pressure from ST. BRIGID'S CROSS to the outside, spun three wide into upper stretch, dug in head to head to the eighth pole, then inched away gamely in the late stages to prevail. ST. BRIGID'S CROSS broke out a step at the start bumping ZUBY, prompted the pace four then three wide coming under a ride at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide into upper stretch, dug in head to head to the sixteenth marker fighting on to the finish but was shaken off in the late stages while clear for the place honors. CARADISE broke out a step at the start, chased three then two wide coming under urging three furlongs out, angled five wide into upper stretch, kept on to the wire. ZUBY took an awkward first step from the gate and was bumped by ST. BRIGID'S CROSS, who broke out a step, chased five paths off the inside briefly before tucking three wide five and a half furlongs from home, began to climb facing some kickback in behind a rival, tipped out five wide at the seven-sixteenths, came under urging three furlongs out, went seven wide into upper stretch, weakened in the drive. PATTY'S GIRL six paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked four wide through the turn coming under coaxing at the three-eighths marker, swung three to four wide into upper stretch and tired.

BOURBON DAY hustled from the gate, raced along the inside latched on the leader through to the one mile marker before easing off to tip outside that rival, went three to four paths off the inside down the backstretch settling in closest aim of the leader, tucked to the two path through the far turn and was patiently handled until set down angled four to five wide into upper stretch, took over command straightened away, drew clear under a drive and was ridden out to the finish. DONEGAL SURGES broke in a step at the start, chased three then two wide coming under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, went six wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while running on to secure the place honors. CERTIFIED LOVERBOY bobbled at the break and came under hustling to show the way in hand just off the inside, tucked inside through the far turn, spun three wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. BRAMITO coaxed from the start, chased five then four wide coming under urging at the seven-sixteenths, tipped out six to seven wide into upper stretch, improved position to the finish. EMIRATES ROAD coaxed from the gate, chased just off the inside and then along the inside under a ride from the seven-sixteenths pole, spun two to three wide for home, weakened in the stretch. TOP GUN ROCKET four then three wide in pursuit, got ridden along half a mile from home, went four wide at the head of the stretch, tired.

ESCAPE HALL stalked the pace from the outside and was three wide on the turn, made a three to four wide bid by the quarter pole to gain command and drew clear to the furlong marker and then drew away under crop urging to prove much the best. SOCIABLY JOHNNY was allowed to settle early, three wide while climbing on the turn, came four wide off the turn and finished well to gain the place award late while no threat to the winner. WHISKEY RUNNER pressed the pace and was two wide on the turn, between rivals by the quarter pole and weakened while winning the battle for the show award. WINSTON D set a pressured pace along the inside and was headed and lost the lead nearing the quarter pole and weakened in the drive while being out-kicked late for the show award. WHISKEY STONES chased the early pace and was on the inside to the two path on the turn but weakened. TUSCAN THUNDER was off a step slow and raced towards the inside early while being outrun, then was in the two path on the turn and never threatened. RICHIES LOVE was off slowly and raced greenly while far back early, raced in the four to five wide path on the turn and never factored.

DILIELLO coaxed from the gate, chased just off the inside coming under a ride at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive to wear down the leader inside the final sixteenth and was up in the final forty yards to prevail. TIZLAWRY broke out at the start forcing out TAKE A STANCE, chased three wide under a ride from three furlongs out, angled five wide into upper stretch, kicked on belatedly to the finish and was just up on the wire for the place honors. TRUE LEGEND coaxed from the start, showed the way in hand along the inside through swift splits under pressure from THIRSTED to the outside, cut the corner roused into upper stretch, edged clear under a drive to the eighth pole, dug in growing leg weary and was caught forty yards from home and then got nailed on the wire for the place honors. ABACUS coaxed from the gate, chased two to three wide coming under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick. MO CURLS got bumped at the start by NEVER SAY UNCLE, chased just off the inside coming under urging at the three-eighths pole, spun three wide for home, offered up a mild bid but was outkicked. THIRSTED coaxed from the start, pressed the pace from the two path under encouragement from the five-sixteenths, spun three wide for home, weakened. MAJOR BOURBON struck the near side stall at the start, chased just off the inside under urging from three furlongs out, angled out five to six wide into upper stretch, had the rider attempt to tip out an additional path a furlong out and had his charge stay put and made no impact. BLAME IT ON K J was reserved early, made a three to four wide run on the far turn and came six wide into the lane and ran on well late to gain the place award but was no match for the winner. PRETRIAL STATEMENT set a pressed pace on the inside and then repelled two bids by the five sixteenth marker and drew clear leaving the turn but weakened late while staying on for the show award. SAMMY C NOTE steadied in the two path on the first turn then tracked the leaders and moved out to make a three wide bid on the far turn to vie for command but flattened out leaving the turn and weakened. ROMEO VOID was rated along three wide and was four wide on the far turn but lacked the needed rally. NONNO JOE was allowed to settle early, moved out to be five wide entering the far turn and then moved in to be three wide by the quarter pole and came four wide off the turn but had no rally. KLIMT MASTER tracked the leaders from the inside and continued to save ground on the far turn but tired. STROBE LIGHT was settled along the inside and dropped back on the far turn. POWERED BY COAL pressed the pace three to two wide and made a

bid between rivals to vie for command by the five sixteenths but tired.
