FOR THE LADIES struck the off side stall at the start, advanced after the break to take command just after the start, showed the way in hand four paths off the rail down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn until tucked to the two path inside the five-sixteenths, continued just off the inside into upper stretch under taps with the crop to the right shoulder, drew off under very light urging and intermittent taps to the right shoulder and prevailed comfortably in hand on the wire. IT'S CAROL'S WAY coaxed from the gate, chased just off the inside down the backstretch and then along the inside through the turn under encouragement from three furlongs out, angled three wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while keeping on to preserve the place honors on the wire. SHE'S ALL CLOVER coaxed from the start, chased six paths off the rail down the backstretch before heading five wide through the turn coming under coaxing at the three-eighths marker, continued six wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild bid. RAGE BAIT coaxed from the gate, chased five then four wide in closest aim of the leader under a ride from midway on the turn, went four wide into upper stretch, weakened in the drive.

TWO BITS veered out at the start and bumped with a rival then dropped back, angled in towards the rear, established a good position towards the front, was given her cue while inside on the turn, gained to make a rail bid in upper stretch, took the lead under a drive just inside the furlong marker and edged clear under strong handling. THREE SIXTY bobbed after the start while going to the front, showed the way on the inside of a foe, vied inside to the two path on the turn, was asked outside the five-sixteenths pole, led under a drive into the final furlong then was headed by the winner and was outfinished while well clear for the place. BAFFLE broke in then was hustled, steadied briefly when the winner dropped in front early then moved out, went around the turn in the four then five path under urging, turned into upper stretch under a drive and was along for the show. COME ON GET HAPPY broke in at the start, was rated towards the front, dropped back late on the backstretch, was roused in two then three path on the turn, spun into the stretch under a drive, moved out some around the furlong marker and lacked the needed response. PERMUTATION was bumped at the start then forced into another rival and off a bit slow, moved up to press the pace on the outside, vied in the two then three path while asked on the turn, dropped back into upper stretch and tired. ROMALA was bumped at the start and off a bit slow, raced on the outside while urged along, chased in the three then four path on the turn and came up empty.

HIGHER FORCE three then two wide through the first turn, settled three wide in closest aim of the leader, tucked to the two path into the far turn and advanced to engage FAST AND FRISKY in head to head combat from three furlongs out, cornered three wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive getting herded out four paths by her main foe from the three-sixteenths to the eighth pole when taking command, then edged clear under a drive in the final sixteenth. FAST AND FRISKY coaxed from the gate, showed the way in hand just off the inside and then along the inside, came under pressure and knocked heads with the aforementioned foe from the three-eighths marker and was placed to urging at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under threat and came outwards three to four paths from the three-sixteenths to just inside the eighth pole and yielded the front at that station, dug in and ran on to preserve the place honors on the wire. ROYAL BOBBIE struck the near side stall at the start and was away last losing her lane to HELLO BEAUTY, raced four then three wide through the first turn advancing on the front in tandem with HELLO BEAUTY seven furlongs out before settling four paths off the inside into the backstretch, tucked three wide into the far turn, came under urging at the three-eighths pole, swung four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and surged home in the late stages to just miss for the show honors on the line. HELLO BEAUTY broke out at the start filling the space left vacant by ROYAL BOBBIE, raced three wide through the first turn briefly advancing with that foe seven furlongs out before settling two to three wide down the backstretch, went four wide through the far turn under urging from the three-eighths pole, angled five wide into upper stretch and weakened. MOMMASGOTTAGUN chased two then three wide under a ride from three furlongs out, went four to five wide into upper stretch, made no impact. AH CA IRA broke out at the start filling the space left vacant by HELLO BEAUTY, chased along the inside under encouragement from midway on the far turn, spun two to three wide at the head of the stretch and tired.

LOOMS BOLDLY coaxed from the gate, showed the way in hand along the inside patiently handled until roused taking the inside route into upper stretch, edged away to the furlong grounds, then held clear to the finish kept to task. BERMUDA BLITZ coaxed from the gate, chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under encouragement three furlongs out, spun three wide into upper stretch, rallied to duel with the runner up through the final furlong and was up in the last jumps to score. NUANCED coaxed from the start, came outwards and forced POROSITY to steady, showed the way in hand along the inside patiently handled until roused taking the inside route into upper stretch, dug in under threat, dueled through the final furlong and was out-gamed in the final strides and nailed on the wire.
