WAVELESS was hustled to the front, showed the way under urging, was challenged near the nine-sixteenths pole, saved ground on the turn, responded well when asked for her best in upper stretch, fought on even terms with the runner-up into the final furlong, turned back that opponent outside the sixteenth-pole and proved best while pricking her ears late. FORMAGGIO came outward at the start, showed speed then tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid in the two to three path on the turn, turned into upper stretch on even terms for the lead, battled with the winner under a drive into the final furlong then was turned away and proved no match while clear for the place. RELEVATE broke in at the start, was well placed just off the pace, chased inside on the turn, came out into upper stretch, drifted out under a left-handed crop near the furlong marker then switched to a right-handed crop and weakened but held the show. LAYLANI LOU broke out and bumped with a foe, moved in outside the five-eighths pole then came under urging, went around the turn in the two to three path, was carried out into upper stretch then raced off heels passing the three-sixteenths pole, came to the furlong marker just behind a foe again then moved in and lacked the needed response. ENDLESS KISS bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along on the outside, went around most of the turn in the three path then dropped to the two path and failed to respond. PAY THE BILLS (FR) bumped with a rivals on both sides while off a step slow then was squeezed back, moved in under urging at the rear, saved ground on the turn, came out into upper stretch and was no factor. FOLLOWING THE RACE, THE RIDER OF LAYLANI LOU LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST RELEVATE ALLEGING INTERFERENCE IN UPPER STRETCH. AFTER THE STEWARDS' REVIEW, NO CHANGE WAS MADE TO THE ORDER OF FINISH

TIME TO WIN broke in a step at the start brushing ROGER ROGER, raced four wide in aim of the top pair coming under coaxing three furlongs out, advanced on the front to take command nearing the quarter pole, continued four wide into upper stretch, shied out under a lone left hand crop just outside the eighth pole, drew clear under a vigorous hand ride shying slightly once more a sixteenth out when just getting a look at the tucked away crop to the left side. SALVATION broke out a step at the start brushing ROGER ROGER, chased just off the inside under urging from the three-eighths pole, angled six wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while running on to secure the place honors, clear of the rest. ROGER ROGER broke in at the start trading a brush with SALVATION and then got brushed by TIME TO WIN, dueled briefly with IMPLACABLE before pressing that rival from the outside in the three path, came under urging at the five-sixteenths when taking narrow and brief command, got headed nearing the quarter pole and spun three wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. TIZ FREEDOM chased eight paths off the rail down the backstretch, tucked to the two path half a mile from home, came under urging three furlongs out, swung four then three wide for home and weakened. LOVE'M OR LIAM coaxed from the gate, chased six paths off the inside down the backstretch and then five wide through the turn under a ride from the three-eighths marker, cornered six wide at the head of the stretch and weakened. IMPLACABLE dueled inside of ROGER ROGER early on before establishing sole command while under pressure from that rival to the outside, tipped to the two path through the turn and yielded the front with five-sixteenths to go, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, faltered, and was eased home through the final furlong to the finish.

SHADOW SURGE was restless in the gate, broke out and brushed the gate then was hustled, showed speed then set the pace, moved to a solo lead late on the backstretch, extended the advantage while inside on the turn, was given his cue inside the five-sixteenths pole, came under the crop in upper stretch, drew off into the final furlong and maintained a save advantage under strong urging. SPIRIT DRAGON was hustled from the gate then chased the pace on the outside, dropped back leaving the backstretch, went around the turn in the four path, was driven into the stretch in the five path and finished willingly for the place. DARK VECTOR dropped well behind and was urged along at the rear, saved ground for most of the turn then shifted to the three path, came out to the five path near the quarter-pole then moved further out and improved for the show. READY SET TWIRL was hustled from the gate, showed speed between horses then chased the pace, moved from the two path to the three path on the turn, spun into the stretch in the four path, remained on his inside lead in the drive and lacked the needed response. PANDEMIC HERO showed speed then pressed the pace, chased late on the backstretch, dropped from the three path to the two path on the turn, pursued the winner into the stretch and tired. MCDIESEL was urged along towards the rear, traveled around the turn in the two path and failed to rally. TAPWRITS TEMPER stood a bit impatiently in the gate, was away awkwardly then angled out early, raced on the outside under urging, rounded the turn in the five path, spun into upper stretch in the seven path and failed to respond.

WILLINTORISKITALL was rated towards the front then stalked the pace, ranged up to make a bid in the four path on the turn, took the lead while asked at the quarter-pole, led under a drive into the final sixteenth but was caught and just missed while clear for the show. FRIZZANTE chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, went seven wide into upper stretch, rallied to issue a challenge inside the final furlong, seized command seventy yards from the finish and edged away to the wire. REGISTER coaxed from the gate, chased three wide coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, swung four wide into upper stretch and took over command straightened away, dug in under threat, got caught seventy yards from the finish, ran on clear for the place honors. COMPLEX MUSIC lunged at the break bumping SMILENSAYCHEESE, chased along the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn under coaxing from midway,

angled out eight wide into upper stretch, kept on to the wire. FREE DANCE chased just off the pace four wide coming under urging near the quarter pole, tipped five wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. SMILENSAYCHEESE got bumped at the start by COMPLEX MUSIC, who lunged outwards, chased just off the inside under prolonged encouragement from the half mile pole, spun three wide for home and improved position to the finish. LOU chased four wide under urging from three furlongs out, angled five to six wide into upper stretch, passed tired rivals. AERO STAR coaxed from the start, cut the pace from the two path widening away to the turn, had the field steadily take closer order three furlongs out, came under encouragement near the quarter pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch under threat, yielded the front straightened away and weakened. JUNGLE GLOW chased three then four wide under a ride from the three-eighths marker, angled out seven to eight wide at the top of the stretch, made no impact. SOLO EMPIRE chased just off the inside under prolonged urging from the half mile pole, angled four wide at the head of the stretch, tired.
