BRAVE BUCK coaxed from the gate, chased four wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths marker, tipped six wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive rallying through the final furlong, was up in the final forty yards to prevail. CATHEDRAL BEACH chased two then three paths off the inside down the backstretch, went five wide through the turn under urging from the seven-sixteenths, angled seven wide into upper stretch and closed well to secure the place honors. FOR SOME REASON coaxed from the start, dueled from the two path with SCARAMANGA to his inside, came under coaxing near the quarter pole, swung four wide into upper stretch, edged clear under a drive to the eighth pole, dug in under threat and was caught in the final forty yards to the finish. O P FIRECRACKER chased along the inside under a ride from the seven-sixteenths marker, angled three to four wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid but was outkicked to the end. SCARAMANGA coaxed from the gate, dueled inside of FOR SOME REASON coming under a ride near the quarter pole, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, weakened.

SCHOOLYARDSUPERMAN prompted the pace on the inside of the leader, drew even with that foe inside the three-quarter pole, took a narrow advantage outside the nine-sixteenths pole, vied inside on the turn, shook clear when asked outside the quarter-pole, turned into the stretch under the crop and drew off under strong urging to prove much the best. BUNTUS FOCLORA made light contact with a foe at the start then bumped lightly again with that opponent, showed the way on the outside, lost the lead near the nine-sixteenths pole, was asked in the three path on the turn, dropped back outside the quarter-pole and proved no match for the winner while just able to get the place. MR. MIRACLE bumped lightly with a foe at the start then came in and made mild contact with that rival, was rated off the pace, came under urging in the five then four path on the turn, chased under a drive into upper stretch and just missed the place while clear for the show. DOUBLE ACT dropped back early then moved out while settling off the pace, was urged along late on the backstretch, traveled around the turn in the three path and lacked the needed response. GOOD ILLUSION bobbled after the start, was well placed just off the pace, drafted in the two path for most of the turn, dropped to the rail while asked late on that bend and came up empty. STREAM IT was off slow and spotted the front several lengths then was hustled, moved out leaving the chute, went around the turn in the four then five path and was no factor. JET OFF tracked the pace on the outside, chased in the four path on the turn, dropped back late on that bend, spun into the stretch in the five path and faltered.

ZANY broke in at the start bumping SHILLING, raced forwardly placed just off the inside through the first turn before tipping to the three path down the backstretch and latching on the leader to the outside six and a half furlongs from home, attended the leader down the backstretch with a lane between them applying little pressure save through her presence, tucked to the two path into the far turn and came under light coaxing to intensify the pressure through the turn, spun three wide into upper stretch taking over command, straightened away clear and in front to the inside, then went clear under a drive and was geared down in the late stages to prevail comfortably on the line. JUMPING THE GUN broke out a step at the break brushing SHILLING, chased just off the inside from just off the pace coming under prolonged coaxing half a mile from home, spun three wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while running on to secure the place honors. CONCURRENTLY just off the inside through the first turn, chased three to four paths off the inside down the backstretch, went three wide through the far turn put to encouragement with seven-sixteenths to go, tipped five wide at the head of the stretch and improved position to the finish to procure the show honors on the wire. SHILLING got brushed at the start by JUMPING THE GUN and then bumped by ZANY and broke on top despite it under coaxing to establish command, settled in hand along the inside showing the way safely in front until ZANY latched on six and a half furlongs from home, settled into a comfortable rhythm down the backstretch, remained along the rail and came under increasing pressure from the top one through the far turn and was placed to coaxing at the five-sixteenths marker in response, yielded the front at the quarter pole and cornered three then two wide into upper stretch, then weakened through to the finish. BELIEVABLE raced three wide through the first turn just off the top pair, tipped out and chased four paths off the rail down the backstretch, came under urging with half a mile to run and continued four wide through the far turn, angled six wide at the top of the stretch and tired. IVY GIRL raced just off the inside through the first turn, chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under urging half a mile from home, went three wide at the head of the lane and trailed throughout.

PALADIN got bumped at the break by I DID I DID, who broke in a step, chased two to three wide coming under a ride at the three-eighths marker, went seven wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command just outside the eighth pole, then edged away to the finish kept to task. SUNDAY BOY chased four then three wide under a ride from the seven-sixteenths pole, angled eight wide into upper stretch, rallied outside to take command nearing the sixteenth pole, then edged clear to the finish kept busy to the end. COMBAT MISSION chased five then four wide coming under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled four to five wide into upper stretch, rallied loosely between foes and seized narrow and brief command inside the eighth pole before being displaced by the aforementioned rival, ran on willingly well clear of the rest to secure the place honors. MUSCLE SHOALS chased four wide coaxed along from the three-eighths pole, angled out seven wide into upper stretch and improved position to garner the show honors. PARKER BOONE broke out at the start under coaxing filling the space left vacant by FROUTIEN, showed the way in hand just off the inside, got roused spinning three wide into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was caught just inside the eighth pole, then weakened in the late stages. DINGHY BAR got away to an awkward start, chased four wide under a ride from the seven-sixteenths marker, went eight to nine wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals. HURRICANE KAZ forwardly placed four paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked three wide through the turn coming under encouragement three furlongs out, spun two to three wide into upper stretch and weakened. SPIRIT OF NEW YORK chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under a ride at the five-sixteenths, angled out near the quarter pole forcing DIAMOND CHILD to steady off his heels, went six wide at the head of the stretch and tired. SICILIAN DANCER chased just off the inside under a ride from the seven-sixteenths, angled out nine wide at the head of the stretch and tired. HEY PAL chased five then four wide under urging from the three-eighths pole, went seven to eight wide at the top of the lane, tired. FROUTIEN hesitated at the start getting away last and conceding five to six lengths to the front, chased along the inside and then just off the inside, cornered from the two path into upper stretch and made no impact. TAKAHAMA chased just off the inside under encouragement from the seven-sixteenths marker, angled five wide into upper stretch, made no impact. CHUMMERS chased along the inside under a ride from the five-sixteenths, took the inside route into upper stretch, faltered, and was eased home through the final furlong. DIAMOND CHILD broke out at the start bumping TRUE LEGEND, chased three then two wide, got forced to steady off the heels of SPIRIT OF NEW YORK before heading five wide into upper stretch, folded, and was eased home through the final eighth to the wire. TRUE LEGEND bobbed at the break and was bumped by DIAMOND CHILD, chased just off the inside and then along the inside ridden along from three furlongs out, angled three to four wide into upper stretch, tired and was eased home to the finish.
