RAGING SEA CAPTAIN coaxed from the gate, chased four then three wide coming under a ride at the three-eighths marker, advanced and took over narrow command swinging four wide into upper stretch, edged away to the eighth pole, dug in and held clear to the finish. LEXINGTON PIKE coaxed from the start, raced forwardly placed among a developing pace dispute and eased off, chased along the inside under prolonged encouragement from the half mile pole, angled five wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick. BEARY FUNNY chased three paths off the inside down the backstretch before tipping out five wide through the turn coming under coaxing with seven-sixteenths to go, angled seven wide into upper stretch, rallied outside to close in through the final furlong and was just up on the wire coming inwards and bumping MERICA'S BACK on the line in a blanket finish. ROOFER stumbled at the start, recovered under brief coaxing to duel six paths off the inside down the backstretch with EAST COAST GIRL to her inside, tucked four then three wide through the turn patiently handled, swung four to five wide into upper stretch in narrow command and was roused straightened away, came out under threat and herded MERICA'S BACK two paths just outside the eighth pole, then an additional path near the sixteenth marker before being angled in to get away from that rival, dug in and was nailed on the wire. FULLY SUBSCRIBED three wide through the first turn, attended the leader latched on to the outside four then three wide patiently handled, took over narrow command at the quarter pole and was set down spinning five wide into upper stretch, drew clear under a drive to prevail. QUIETSIDE four then three wide through the first turn, chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then four wide through the far turn coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, angled six to seven wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while running on to secure the place honors. OURDAYDREAMINGGIRL got bumped at the start by KAPPA KAPPA, raced just off the inside through the first turn, chased four then three wide coming under urging at the seven-sixteenths, swung four wide for home, kept on to the finish. YES IT TIZ tossed her head as the latch was sprung and was caught in the hand of the assistant starter and was away awkwardly, raced along the inside through the first turn before tipping three paths off the inside down the backstretch, continued three wide through the far turn coming under encouragement at the five-sixteenths pole, angled six to seven wide into upper stretch and improved position to the finish. VALTELLINA along the inside through the first turn, chased six then four wide under urging from the five-sixteenths marker, went eight wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals to the finish. KAPPA KAPPA broke in at the start bumping OURDAYDREAMINGGIRL, raced forwardly placed before establishing the front seven and a half furlongs out while just off the inside through the first turn, showed the way in hand three then two wide under the watchful eye of her accompaniment of the top one to the outside, came under urging near the quarter pole and spun four then three wide into upper stretch displaced from command, then weakened through to the wire. NOTICEABLE showed the way early on along the inside before being displaced from the front by the aforementioned foe midway on the first turn, settled in pursuit just off the inside and then along the inside coming under urging with five-sixteenths to run, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and tired in the drive. There was a Stewards' Inquiry into the start focusing on YES IT TIZ. After review, it was deemed that YES IT TIZ was in the hands of the assistant starter at the break and therefore YES IT TIZ was declared a nonstarter prior to the result being declared official.

BLENHEIM BABY raced well back in the field, went around the turn in the two path and improved for the place. CHA CHA WREN settled under some urging, went around the turn in the two path, moved out in upper stretch and lacked the needed response while best of the rest. ITWILLBEFUN broke awkwardly then was taken up and off slow, was reserved under restraint behind horses, became keen when removed from cover early on the backstretch, rushed up to get the lead with five furlongs to run, opened up a sizable advantage shortly thereafter, went around the turn in the two path, shortened stride into upper stretch then was collared by the winner and tired. THAT'STHEFACTJACK was urged along off the pace, went around the turn in the five path, spun into the stretch in the six path and failed to threaten.

SPIRIT OF ESTHER pressed the early pace, chased late on the backstretch, dropped from the three path to the inside on the turn and came up empty. FURRY FOX shied and was taken up leaving the chute, settled under some urging, moved from the rail to the two path late on the turn and was no factor. CALLING AN AUDIBLE was hustled from the gate, pressed the early pace, dropped back with five furlongs to run, went around the turn in the four path and had nothing left. WIDDERSHINS was hustled from the gate, disputed the pace, dropped back inside the five-eighths pole, saved ground on the turn and retreated. BOW TO CLARA bobbled just after the start, moved up to dispute the pace, dropped back with five furlongs to run, moved from the three path to the five path on the turn, spun into the stretch in the six path and faltered.
