COLLECT THE DATA forwardly placed from the start, led briefly before being displaced from command by WILD MAMA seven furlongs out, advanced from the two path to take back the front with five furlongs to go and showed the way just off the inside and then along the inside patiently handled, took the inside route into upper stretch and was roused with three-sixteenths remaining, drew clear under a drive and got geared down with seventy yards to the finish. WALK WITH ME chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn coming under encouragement at the five-sixteenths pole, swung four to five wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while along well clear of the rest and second best. SAVE US MELANIA stumbled at the start recovering outwards with a lunge squeezing out SHE'S FASCINATING and bumping BROADWAY LIGHTS in tandem with WILD MAMA, chased three paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking inside through the turn, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and weakened in the late stages while along for the show honors.
