WARRENS WORLD raced not too far behind the pace four wide, moved up through the far turn to make a six wide bid entering the stretch and kicked clear in the final furlong. CLUB MESQUITE opted to race five wide in the middle of the pack, saved ground in the far turn, forced out four wide entering the stretch, rallied. HOLD TIGHT bumped at the start, trailed for most, gained position three wide in the far turn, made an inside bid in the final furlong to show a mild rally but flattened out late. ROSIE'S BOY bumped at the start, raced in the middle of the pack before settling off the pace, trailed through the far turn, split foes four wide in the final furlong and closed willingly. BRAYBRAY pressed the pace from the inside before taking command after the first quarter, drifted out in the upper stretch, relinquished the lead just before the final furlong and retreated. REQUISITION settled off the pace on the inside, passed tired foes in the stretch. CUCINA stalked the early pace three wide, retreated in the final furlong. PRINCE OTTO set the early pressured pace in the two path between foes, relinquished the lead after the first quarter and stalked the pace, dropped back in the far turn to angle towards the far outside of the stretch but had nothing left, eased across.
