TIZ GIGI was unhurried at the start to be the early trailer, gained position along the outside of the turn to enter the stretch six wide, steadily picked off remaining rivals through the final furlong to earn the victory. DELIGHTFUL RESERVE quickly claimed the lead to set a pressured pace, entered the stretch three wide to give way to inside foe, started to come again before getting passed by outside rival in the final sixteenth. WARREN'S C J settled off the pace on the inside, split foes going into the the turn, showed a mild rally in the stretch to be up for show. ROMANS WORD tracked the early pace from the inside, bid for the lead when the one hole opened up at the three sixteenths but could not sustain bid and was out-finished. GEORGE'S SURPRISE raced four wide in the middle of the pack, weakened in the stretch. SUNTASTIC pressed the early pace, backed off and retreated in the final furlong. NAUTICAL MILE rated between rivals three wide early, trailed at the three eighths, eased across. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate final time.
