RANCH REBEL was quick to set the pace and held firmly through the stretch. O'NEILL'S LEGACY settled off the pace, gained position five wide through the turn, to enter the stretch in a prominent position, showed a mild rally but didn't have enough to win. SAHARA SUE settled back to be the distant trailer, took to the far outside of the stretch to show an impressive rally. PRINCESS VANELLOPE opted to race in the middle of the pack between rivals, finished well to improve position. UNKNOWN CALLER tracked the pace five wide, saved ground to enter the stretch behind the pace, weakened late in the stretch. SQUARE FOOTAGE tracked the pace from the inside, retreated in the stretch. SABRIA stalked the early pace three wide, retreated in the stretch. SOUTHERN SPEIGHT raced off the pace, made no impact. CAN'T WANT THAT tracked the early pace four wide, retreated in the final quarter. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate final time.
