

CARLIN CONTENTION broke in at the start bumping IRON MAX, chased of the stretch and then four wide through the turn urged along from the seven-sixteenths, cornered two to three wide at the head of the head stretch and then four wide through the turn urged along from the seven-sixteenths, cornered two to three wide at the head of the stretch and tired.
