MILA CANDY bumped hard with a rival at the start, was rated while well placed just off the pace, drafted inside to the two path on the turn, came under light coaxing inside the five-sixteenths pole then continued to draft behind horses, was roused in the three path into the stretch, chased outside into the final furlong, gained into the final sixteenth and got up to prevail. SPORTING LADY broke alertly then was hustled, angled in early then showed the way on the inside of a rival, vied along the rail while on even terms with that foe on the turn, responded well when set down near the quarter-pole, shook clear in upper stretch, came under a right-handed crop outside the furlong marker, switched to a left-handed crop outside the sixteenth-pole, led until about the final seventy yards but was caught while clear for the place. NUMBERED was reluctant to load, bumped hard with rivals at the start, climbed some while urged along off the pace, moved from the two path to the four path while ridden along on the turn, was driven into the stretch in the five path and lacked the needed kick while up for the show. SHIRL'S DELIGHT had her saddle adjusted behind the gate, broke out then was hustled, moved up to press the pace on the outside, drew even with the leader while in the two path on the turn, was urged along passing the five-sixteenths pole, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and weakened. CARA'S CHIANTI was reluctant to load, broke in then bumped solidly with a foe and was off a bit slow, spotted the front a few lengths, moved out early then advanced outside under urging, chased in the three path through the turn and tired. YANKEE DOODLE brushed the outside of the gate and was off a bit slow, moved out early then was urged along at the rear, fell much further behind near the seven-sixteenths pole, rounded the turn in the two to three path and was no factor.

FLOGE got bumped after the start by RAW POWER due to pressure from HALO CITY, raced five then four wide in aim of the front, tucked three wide into the turn and advanced on the leader coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, swung five to six wide into upper stretch seizing command straightened away, edged away under a drive to prevail. IT TAKES HEART cut the pace along the inside under some pressure from TRADE SECRET to the outside and then increased pressure from a pair through the turn, came under urging outside the quarter pole, tipped three wide into upper stretch and yielded the front straightened away, ran on to chase the winner home well clear of the rest and along second best. HALO CITY broke in at the start bumping RAW POWER into FLOGE, chased six paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn under encouragement from the seven-sixteenths, went eight wide into upper stretch and improved position to the finish. GOLDCREST chased seven paths off the inside down the backstretch until tucked four wide nearing the half mile pole, came under coaxing three wide at the three-eighths marker, went seven wide into upper stretch and weakened in the drive. RAW POWER got bumped at the start by HALO CITY and in turn bumped FLOGE before being pinched out between foes soon after and conceded three lengths to the front, chased just off the inside and then along the inside ridden along from the seven-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and tired. TRADE SECRET brushed the near side stall at the start, dueled briefly with IT TAKES HEART before prompting that rival from the outside three wide down the backstretch and then from the two path between foes through the turn, came under urging midway, angled four wide into upper stretch and tired.

JOHN THE BAPTIST broke in at the start, showed speed then disputed the pace on the inside of foes, moved clear late on the backstretch, controlled the action in the two path on the turn, responded well when asked near the five-sixteenths pole, extended the advantage a bit further off the inside into upper stretch then came under the crop, drew off under the crop until just before the sixteenth-pole then was placed under a solid hand-ride to the finish while much the best. SPIRIT DRAGON veered in at the start and was off a bit slow, moved out while advancing closer to the pace, dropped in leaving the backstretch, shifted from rail to the two path near the three-eighths pole, angled to the four path outside the five-sixteenths pole, turned into the stretch in the five path and finished willingly to get the place. VERY SATISFACTORY was ridden along at the rear, saved ground on the turn, gained under a drive into upper stretch and improved willingly to get the show. BATTLE ANTHEM was sent hard from the gate, tracked the pace on the outside, was roused late on the backstretch, dropped back in the five then four path on the turn, spun into the stretch in the five path and lacked the needed response. HER SUGAR BABY broke out and bumped with an opponent, showed speed then pressed the pace, dropped back late on the backstretch, chased in the three path on the turn, spun into upper stretch in the four path then drifted out a bit more and tired. KLIMT MASTER was bumped at the start, showed speed then contested the pace on the outside, dropped back near the half-mile pole, chased in the four then three path on the turn and tired. PRAIRIE DUNES was hustled from the gate, settled off the pace, moved out near the nine-sixteenths pole, went around the turn in the six then five path, came into the stretch in the six path and was no factor.
