BLUE ROOF BEAU took a first awkward step from the gate, vied inside a pair of rivals early on and then emerged to duel with BYE FOR NOW through the turn coming under light coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, took the inside route into upper stretch, edged clear just given rein to run to the eighth pole, held clear to the finish kept under hand urging being shown the crop to the right side once to keep his mind on his task. HURRICANE KAZ broke out at the start brushing BOSSOFEVERYTHING, chased five then four wide coming under urging with seven-sixteenths to go, angled five to six wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick. BOSSOFEVERYTHING got brushed at the break by the aforementioned foe, chased six the five wide coming under a ride with seven-sixteenths to run, cornered five wide into upper stretch, kicked on belatedly to the finish. PROSPECTOR got taken in hand at the break when against the bit and was away last, chased four then three wide coaxed along from the get go, angled six wide into upper stretch, passed tired rivals. BYE FOR NOW hustled from the gate, vied outside a pair of rivals from the four path, tucked three then two wide emerging to duel with the top one through the turn coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun three wide into upper stretch and tired. ROCOLINO coaxed from the start, vied early on between foes from the three path, got shaken off near the half mile pole and chased just off the inside through the turn coaxed along from the seven-sixteenths marker, tipped four wide into upper stretch and faltered in the drive.

REMI'S MOON stalked the pace on the outside while under a hard hold, four wide on the turn and inched closer on the turn and when ready took over leaving the quarter pole and drew off in the lane under mild left handed crop urging to prove much the best. JACKSON HEIGHTS was taken back early on the outside and raced four wide on the turn, came six wide into the lane and ran on willingly to gain the place award while no match for the winner. LOOMS BOLDLY set a pressured pace early on the rail, then vied for the command from the three eighths marker to the quarter pole but weakened in the lane while holding on to the show award. SHERIFF BIANCO was off a step slow and settled early, raced in the two path on the turn and came three wide off the turn and angled out but had no late kick. SHARED SUCCESS was allowed to settle on the inside and saved ground on the turn, came two wide off the turn and angled out nearing the three sixteenths but had no rally. SPIRIT DRAGON pressed the pace and made a two wide bid to vie for command by the three eighths marker to the quarter pole but weakened in the drive.

TRICKY BUSINESS coaxed from the gate, settled just off the duel six paths off the rail down the backstretch, advanced into the turn tucked three wide and dueled with JUDGE BOUSHAY taking over command just outside the quarter pole when placed to urging, swung four wide into upper stretch, edged clear under a drive kept to task. JUDGE BOUSHAY lunged at the break, dueled from the five path with KING FARRO to his inside down the backstretch, tucked to the two path into the turn, shook off that rival when confronted by the top and dueled once more with a new rival coming under coaxing with five-sixteenths to run, spun three wide into upper stretch displaced from command, ran on to chase the winner home through the final furlong clear of the rest and along second best. KING FARRO bobbed at the break, faltered from the two path with the aforementioned foe to his outside, tucked inside through the turn and was shaken off at the three-eighths marker, angled six wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages while clear of the rest for the show honors. LIAM'S LEGACY chased three then four wide under a ride from three furlongs out, went eight wide into upper stretch, passed tired rivals to the finish. SFUMATO brushed the off side stall at the start, chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn coaxed along from the three-eighths pole, angled six wide into upper stretch, tired. MO CURLS coaxed from the gate, chased four paths off the inside down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the turn under urging with seven-sixteenths to run, spun three then two wide into upper stretch and tired. ANDERMAN coaxed from the start, chased just off the inside and then along the inside under urging from the seven-sixteenths marker, angled four to five wide for home and faltered in the stretch.

JUST FOR LUCK tossed his head at the start and brushed the off side stall when lunging at the break and was away last conceding four to five lengths to the front, settled just off the inside near the rear of the field, tucked inside through the far turn and came under coaxing near the quarter pole, angled seven wide into upper stretch, offered up a good finish to just get up on the wire and score. INSPEIGHTOFCHARLIE coaxed from the gate, tracked the front just off the inside from mid pack, tucked inside through the far turn and came under coaxing three furlongs out, angled four wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command just outside the eighth pole, edged away inside that station, dug in under lone threat to the outside and was nailed on the line. SIX FORTYFIVE

chased just off the inside and then along the inside from near the rear, came under a ride from the three-eighths pole, spun three wide into upper stretch, bid a furlong out, kept on to secure the show honors. JACK'S WORLD three then two wide through the first turn, chased three wide coming under urging at the three-eighths marker, angled six wide into upper stretch, kept on to the finish. A LITTLE AT FIRST raced just off the inside through the first turn, chased four then three wide under encouragement from three furlongs out, cornered four wide into upper stretch, stayed on one paced to the finish. SOLO EMPIRE three wide through the opening turn, chased three to four paths off the inside down the backstretch and through the far turn under coaxing from the three-eighths pole, angled six wide into upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. LACHAISE raced three then two wide through the first turn, chased three then two wide from near the rear of the field, angled five to six wide into upper stretch set down for the drive, offered no response, then got pulled up following the gallop out when returning on the main track and was attended to and vetted on track and subsequently transported off the main track via the equine ambulance. CHUMMERS four then three wide through the first turn, chased five paths off the rail down the backstretch and then three wide through the far turn under urging from three furlongs out, went eight to nine wide into upper stretch and had no kick. ORTUS tracked the pace along the inside under encouragement from midway on the far turn, angled five wide into upper stretch, weakened. MCDIESEL coaxed from the gate, showed the way in hand along the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, took the inside route into upper stretch, dug in under threat from a host of pursuers and was caught just outside the eighth pole, then weakened through to the wire. TIM AND SAM coaxed from the start, raced three wide through the first, tracked the front three wide in closest aim of the leader, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and spun three to four wide for home and tired. UNFAIR chased just off the inside under a ride from the three-eighths pole, went three wide at the head of the stretch, tired.
