DANNEEL coaxed from the gate, chased two to three wide down the backstretch before tucking to the rail into the turn, came under coaxing nearing the five-sixteenths advancing to issue a challenge near the quarter pole, cut the corner into upper stretch taking over the front straightened away, drew clear under a drive, then got geared down in the late stages. CLEAR CONSCIENCE just off the duel tracking along the inside, came under encouragement nearing the quarter pole and swung three wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a furlong out, edged away briefly before digging in under lone threat to the outside and was nailed when losing the bob on the wire. BORN DANCER two to three wide in pursuit from just off the pace, came under urging three furlongs from home, angled four wide into upper stretch, bid a furlong out, then kept on to secure the show honors. SLAPINTHEFACE dueled inside of GEM MINT TEN from the get go coming under coaxing at the late stages. GEM MINT TEN broke in at the start brush8ing CABLE READY, dueled two to three wide with the aforementioned foe to his inside, remained patiently handled until let out spinning from the two path into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and was collared a furlong out, weakened in the late going. CABLE READY got brushed at the start by GEM MINT TEN, who broke inwards, tracked the pace just off the inside from mid pack, came under encouragement three furlongs from home, angled four wide at the top of the stretch, offered no response. LEFTEMBEHIND chased just off the inside and

then along the inside from the five-eighths, came under urging near the quarter pole and cornered just off the inside into upper stretch, offered no kick. KING MOONRACER got rank tossing his head just after the start when placed to a rating hold, went three wide through the first turn, chased two to three wide coming under coaxing three furlongs out, went seven wide into upper stretch and tired.

MY ANTICIPATION broke a bit slow then dropped back, settled at the rear, angled in near the half-mile pole, moved from the rail to the two path on the turn, was roused outside the quarter-pole, swung into the four path at the top of the stretch then moved out more near the three-sixteenths pole, rallied outside into the final furlong and closed strongly to get up in the final sixteenth and prevail. SUGAR RUN showed speed and went to the front, set the pace under pressure to her outside, vied inside on the turn, was given her cue near the five-sixteenths pole, came under the crop in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was denied while just able to hold the place. FIRE'S OUT settled off the pace, dropped back near the half-mile pole, saved ground on the turn, waited while blocked in upper stretch, found room and was roused outside the furlong marker and finished with good energy but was too late and just missed while clear for the show. JUST ADD WATER was bumped at the start and forced out while off a bit slow, settled off the pace, was asked in the three path on the turn, turned into the stretch in the four path, gained outside near the three-sixteenths pole then chased the leader into the final furlong, held a good striking position at that point, drifted in near the sixteenth-pole and lacked the needed kick. MUTUALLY EXCLUSIVE settled off the pace, moved closer with a half-mile to run, was roused in the two path on the turn, spun into the stretch in the three path, was crowded some near the three-sixteenths pole and lacked the needed response. CAHIRA'S SONG angled in while hustled from the gate, showed speed inside of an opponent then chased the pace, saved ground on the turn, came off the rail in upper stretch and tired. HIDDEN AGENDA pressed the pace on the outside, was asked in the two path on the turn, dropped back in upper stretch, drifted out near the sixteenth-pole and also tired.
