NEW YORK SCRAPPY dueled for the lead on the inside and then shook clear on the turn while in the two path, roused nearing the furlong marker and maintained a clear advantage to the wire to prove best. EGYPTIAN was allowed to settle on the inside, remained on the rail on the turn and was sent down leaving the three sixteenths and had a good finish on the inside to gain the place award. COME FULL CIRCLE chased the early pace and inched closer four wide nearing the quarter pole and came five wide off the turn to make a bid and ran on willingly to the wire but was out-kicked for the place award, bested rest. SOLOMINI'S WORLD was away alertly and dueled for the lead outside the winner, three wide on the turn and fell off the pace nearing the three eighths marker and came four wide into the lane but weakened. FIRST PITCH was settled early on the outside, five wide on the turn and came seven wide into the lane but had no rally. RESILIENT HERO was bumped slightly at the break and outrun early on the outside, moved in and saved ground on the turn, came three wide into the lane but never factored.

GEORGE BRIGGS tracked the pace along the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, angled out four wide into upper stretch, rallied inside the final furlong seizing command a sixteenth out, then edged clear to the finish to score. IRON MAX got taken in hand when bumped between foes at the start who each broke a step his way, raced three then two wide through the first turn, tracked the front two to three wide patiently handled until let out spinning three wide into upper stretch, rallied to poke a head in front a furlong out, got collared at the sixteenth pole and ran on to preserve the place honors on the line. CABLE READY broke in a step at the start under coaxing and bumped the aforementioned foe, knocked heads with SANZIO through the first turn and into the backstretch before being shaken off a bit six furlongs from home, advanced along the rail and took over the front at the nine-sixteenths marker, showed the way briefly safe before knocking heads once more with SANZIO through the far turn coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, took the inside route into upper stretch, dug in under new threat to the outside and was collared a furlong out, fought on inside running on to procure the show honors at the finish. OUTSOURCE broke out a step at the start bumping IRON MAX in tandem with CABLE READY and was away last after the exchange, tracked the front along the inside and then just off the inside from near the rear of the field, came under encouragement with five-sixteenths to run, angled out five wide into upper stretch and kept on to the end. ROCK THE WEEKEND chased two to three wide coming under a ride three furlongs out, angled three to four wide into upper stretch, tired. SANZIO forwardly placed from the gate, raced three then two wide through the first turn knocking heads with CABLE READY before establishing narrow yet sole command into the backstretch, showed the way in hand two to three paths off the rail, had CABLE READY advance inside and was displaced from the front with nine-sixteenths to run, ranged up and dueled through the far turn from the two path under encouragement from the five-sixteenths pole, got shaken off and spun two to three wide at the head of the stretch, then tired through to the finish.

CHIPS AND FISH was away alertly and showed the way on the inside and dawdled along down the backside and then kicked clear leaving the turn and remained clear to the wire to prove best, driving. FATEFUL LIGHTNING was reserved early and saved ground throughout, cut the corner leaving the turn and then angled off the inside in the lane and finished well but had to settle for being second best. LANGUID was rated along early on the inside, guided to the outside entering the backside and had three wide pursuit, then continued three wide on the far turn and came four wide into the lane and was along for the show award late. TEUTONIC was allowed to settle early, moved up on the inside down the backside when LANGUID moved to the outside, then raced on the inside to the two path on the far turn and came three wide into the lane, angled out a path in the lane but had no kick while racing one paced. UP FOR AN OSCAR prompted the winner two wide and came three wide into the lane and was roused leaving the three sixteenths but weakened in the final furlong. JOY DIVISION was reserved two wide early, between rivals on the far turn and came three wide into the lane but lacked a rally. RUBY'S TROUBLE chased the early pace two wide and then was shuffled back down the backside on the outside, three wide on the far turn and came five wide into the lane but tired.

BRZINA coaxed from the gate, got coaxed along briefly while three paths off the inside before advancing to vie between barn mates from the nine-sixteenths pole through to the three-eighths marker, had the outside rival's rider peer inwards at that station and began to tuck in to take over the two path in front, eased out from between foes near the five-sixteenths pole and came under urging, angled four to five wide into upper stretch, took over the front with three-sixteenths to go and drew clear under a drive to prevail. MALU got bumped at the start by SANTAGATA, chased five then four wide under a ride from three furlongs out, angled six wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while keeping on to secure the place honors. SABBY SUNSET coaxed from the gate, ended up knocking heads with her barn mate SHORT SHIFT early on and came under a hard hold four paths off the inside, had the top one advance between and was given a notch to work with and vied outside that pair to the three-eighths pole, had the rider peer inwards and steadily tucked in to take away the two path forcing BRZINA to head outside with five-sixteenths to go, spun three wide into upper stretch, held narrow command briefly straightened away before being displaced by the eventual winner and weakened in the late stages while along for the show honors. SHORT SHIFT coaxed from the gate, knocked heads with her barn mate before being engaged by BRZINA with nine-sixteenths to go, vied inside pair of foes coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, took the inside route into upper stretch, yielded the front straightened away and tired. SHADYSIDE coaxed from the start, chased four paths off the inside until tucked to the two path with nine-sixteenths to go, tucked inside through the turn coming under encouragement at the three-eighths marker, swung four wide into upper stretch and made no impact. SANTAGATA broke out at the start bumping MALU, chased five to six paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking to two path into the turn, came under coaxing with seven-sixteenths to run, angled six to seven wide into upper stretch and trailed throughout.

DREAMS OF ROME broke out a step at the start bumping BIG FROSTY, pulled on the bit eager early on just off the inside before settling behind rivals through the first turn, tracked just off the inside until shifted out to the four path into the far turn as most of the field came off the inside when DEACON BLUES began to back away in front along the rail, came under coaxing continuing four wide into upper stretch, tipped out a path a furlong out and rallied with a good kick to overthrow the front inside the final seventy yards to prevail on the wire. BIG FROSTY got bumped at the start by the aforementioned foe, settled tracking the front just off the inside from near the rear of the field, came under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, tipped out a path nearing the sixteenth marker and offered up a good finish surging late to get up for the place honors on the line. MANOR PARK lost his lane at the start to BIG FROSTY due to pressure from DREAMS OF ROME, chased two then three wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths pole, angled four wide into upper stretch and offered no response. PROBE chased along the inside and then just off the inside under urging with five-sixteenths remaining, angled three to four wide for home, tired.
