ALIMARA (FR) bumped with a rival at the start and was a bit slow into stride, saved ground while reserved under a tight hold and unhurried near the back, remained near the back while caught in behind a foe on the final turn, moved to the two path while still un-asked outside the quarter-pole, was roused while moving out in upper stretch then gained between foes, found her best stride in the final furlong and finished fast but was too late while clear for the place. BOBBY JEAN was well placed while rated just off the pace on the inside, came under encouragement on the final turn, pursued the winner under a drive in the stretch and weakened while clear for the show. LINA (FR) was off slow and spotted the front a few lengths, tugged on the bit while reserved in the two to three path at the rear, was roused on the third turn, chased in the four path into upper stretch and lacked the needed response. MENDREL coaxed from the gate, dueled three then two wide with DELIGHTFUL FLAME to her inside, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths and spun





just off the inside into upper stretch and was shaken off a bit straightened away, came again to latch on a furlong out and knocked heads through the final sixteenth to the finish and just got the nod on the wire. DELIGHTFUL FLAME dueled inside of the aforementioned foe down the backstretch and through the turn while along the rail coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, cut the corner into upper stretch roused for the drive getting some separation in doing so, came out a path to look her main danger in the eye just before she latched back on a furlong out, dug in gamely battling on head to head to duel once more to the finish but lost the bob on the line. LADY DORO got bumped at the start by BROADWAY LIGHTS and in turn bumped CDAKHAT in the hind end, chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, swung three wide into upper stretch, kept on to secure the show honors. LINARITE broke out at the start brushing the off side stall at the break, chased just off the inside and then along the inside from the tail of the field, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, went eight wide into upper stretch and kicked on belatedly to the finish. BROADWAY LIGHTS broke in at the start bumping LADY D'ORO into CDAKHAT, chased four then three wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths, went seven wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid. LA GROTTE coaxed from the start, chased four paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked inside at the half mile pole, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and offered no rally. QUICK POWER NAP chased along the inside coming under encouragement at the three-eighths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. BAM'S BLISS KISS four then three wide in pursuit, came under urging with five-sixteenths to go, swung five wide for home and weakened in the stretch. DASHING DELLA five then four wide in pursuit, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled six wide into upper stretch, tired. CDAKHAT (IRE) got bumped in the hind end by LADY D'ORO due to pressure from BROADWAY LIGHTS and was knocked askew, chased three then two wide coming under urging near the quarter pole, swung three to four wide at the top of the stretch, tired in the drive.
