FIERY brushed the off side stall at the start, chased just off the inside under coaxing nearing the quarter pole, angled five wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command with three-sixteenths to go and edged clear under a drive to prevail. KHALI'S STORM broke out at the start and was corrected, led briefly until headed by FIVE DOZEN ROSES for the front five and a half furlongs from home, prompted that rival from the outside in the three path before advancing tucked to the two path into the turn to duel with that foe through the bend, spun three wide for home, got displaced in tandem with her main pace rival at the three-sixteenths, proved no match for the top one while along clear of the rest and second best. GOING FOR GLORY shied out at the start in reaction to the aforementioned foe, chased four to five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn, went five to six wide into upper stretch and improved position to the wire. FIVE DOZEN ROSES established the front five and a half furlongs from home and showed the way in hand along the inside under some pressure from KHALI'S STORM to the outside, had that rival advance into the turn and dueled through the bend coming under urging nearing the quarter pole, took the inside route into upper stretch, yielded the front straightened away and tired. SASSY MAXINE chased two to three wide down the backstretch before tucking inside through the turn coming under a ride three furlongs from home, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, tired. DAYTIME DRAMA coaxed from the start, chased just off the inside under prolonged coaxing from the half mile pole, angled four wide into upper stretch, trailed throughout.

EMPTY TOMB was hustled from the gate, sped clear in tandem with KHAFRE early, tossed his head when taken back off the pace into and early on the first turn, moved from the rail to the two path on that bend, stalked the pace on the outside, made a bid in the three path on the far turn, took the lead outside the quarter-pole, was put to a drive in upper stretch, shook clear outside the furlong marker, responded well under the crop into the final sixteenth then was placed under a hand-ride to the finish while much the best. KHAFRE broke fast then moved in while sent hard, opened up on the rest of the field in tandem with EMPTY TOMB early, moved clear in the two path early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, showed the way down the backstretch, vied inside on the far turn, was asked under heavy threat at the five-sixteenths pole, lost the advantage outside the quarter-pole then was put to the crop and was outfinished while clear for the place. AULA went around the first turn in the three path, moved closer with six furlongs to run then tracked on the outside, was roused at the seven-sixteenths pole, chased in the four path for most of the far turn, dropped to the three path then two path late on that bend, turned into the stretch under a right-handed crop, reached the rail while remaining on his inside lead in the drive and weakened but earned the show. CELESTIAL MOON brushed with a rival at the start, went around the first turn in the two path while between horses, was urged along off the pace, traveled around the far turn in the two then three path, drifted out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. BOLD VICTORY went around the opening bend in the two path, settled well back in the field, moved from the two path to the four path under urging on the far turn and failed to rally. BLAKE B. brushed with a rival at the start, settled on the inside, was roused on the far turn, moved off the rail outside the quarter-pole, angled out in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. STRONG LIGHT dropped back at the start, raced in the three path on the first turn, came under urging on the backstretch while well back on the outside, rounded the far turn in the three path, came out to the six path into the stretch and showed little.

VESTING (IRE) established the front and showed the way rated on the pace along the inside through sensible yet moderate splits, settled into a comfortable rhythm only leaving the rail to be just off the inside through the second turn, remained patiently handled as rivals got busy in behind, cut the corner into upper stretch given a notch to work with, received a tap from the crop to the right shoulder and came under a light drive a furlong out while already clear, received one sole reminder to the right side before being shown the crop and was geared down confidently to the finish, the outcome in no doubt. GREYSTONE saved ground at the tail of the field, came under coaxing tipped to the two path with five-sixteenths to go, angled five wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick to secure the place honors over a rival on the line. BE OF COURAGE along the inside early on, tipped out to track from the two path past the stands the initial time, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and ran on to procure the show honors. CLASSIC CREATION broke a half a beat slow, saved ground near the rear of the field, got set down angled three wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid. HAMILTON'S WAY tracked along the inside just off the pace early on, got forced to check off the heels of LORD FLINTSHIRE when that rival tucked directly in front with eight and a half furlongs to run heading into the second turn, settled once then just off the inside in mid pack, came under urging nearing the quarter pole before being let out taking the two path into upper stretch and weakened in the drive. ST JAMES THE GREAT two to three wide in pursuit, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide into upper stretch and tired. LORD FLINTSHIRE tracked the leader just off the inside in closest aim of that rival, tucked inside eight and a half furlongs from home impeding HAMILTON'S WAY and forcing that rival to check off his heels, tracked inside thereafter coming under coaxing nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner into upper stretch and tired.

COME RAIN OR SHINE got bumped at the start by LAIRD OF MAGNOLIA due to pressure from MAJORCA breaking inwards, settled along the inside in mid pack early on and then just off the inside through the first turn before tipping three to four paths off the rail down the backstretch, went three wide through the far turn coming under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, angled five to six wide into upper stretch, rallied to issue a challenge inside the final furlong in tandem with THE HERO CODE and seized command a sixteenth out, then inched away to the finish.
