BARNSTORMING settled on the inside, was roused near the quarter-pole, chased under a drive into the final furlong, gained to make a bid outside the sixteenth-pole and got up in the final strides to prevail. KID KREESA went to the front, showed the way on the inside with a clear advantage, was asked

coming to the quarter-pole then spun off the rail into the stretch, led under a drive into the final sixteenth but was caught while clear for the place. ROHAN steadied while squeezed back between horses early, raced in the three path on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, came under urging in the three then four path on the far turn, turned into the stretch in the five path, gained outside into the final furlong, drifted in near the sixteenth-pole and finished willingly for the show. PATRICK'S PROMISE dropped from the three path to the two path early on the first turn, settled off the pace, saved ground on the far turn, was roused inside the five-sixteenths pole, shifted into the three path at the quarter-pole, dropped inward in upper stretch and improved position. HARD PAR went around the first turn in the two path, was reserved off the pace, moved from the rail to the two path while roused on the far turn, came into the stretch in the four path, raced between horses into the final furlong, moved out late and just missed the superfecta. KING FREUD had his saddle adjusted behind the gate, saved ground on the first turn, settled at the rear, was roused in the two path on the far turn and was no factor. YOUR MISSION checked while pinched back between horses early, saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, was roused in the three path on the far turn, turned into the stretch in the five path and lacked the needed response. ROYAL BROWNE became rank nearing the first turn then was taken up into that bend, raced in the three path from that point, was rated on the outside, came under encouragement in the three path on the far turn, spun into the stretch in the four path and capitulated. BRODERICK angled in and brushed with a foe early, tracked the pace on the outside in the three then two path, was given his cue on the final turn, chased into the upper stretch and tired. JOHN THE BAPTIST was brushed and forced in early, raced in the four path on the first turn, settled outside without cover, tucked in behind horses near the seven-sixteenths pole, was roused in the two then three path on the far turn, spun into the stretch in the four path and came up empty. MAYBERN coaxed from the gate, chased three then two wide coming under a ride at the three-eighths marker, angled five wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a sixteenth out, then inched away to the finish. ORIE three then two wide in pursuit, came under encouragement three furlongs out, swung three then two wide into upper stretch, rallied to take brief command just outside the sixteenth marker before being displaced at that station and ran on to preserve the place honors clear of the rest on the line. THE COMMISH pressed the pace of NYIKOS from the outside three then two wide coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in rallying to take command a furlong out, got collared on the way to the sixteenth pole, then kept on clear for the show honors. CADA DIA MEJOR chased three then two wide coming under urging at the three-eighths marker, spun three wide into upper stretch, stayed on one paced in the late stages. OUT OF THE FOG got bumped at the start by WIND DANCER, who broke out a step, chased along the inside under coaxing from three furlongs out, took the inside route into upper stretch and stayed on one paced to the finish. MOTEL

PATEL coaxed from the start, chased two then three wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths, angled four wide into upper stretch, weakened in the drive. NYIKOS coaxed from the gate, cut the pace under pressure from THE COMMISH to the outside, took the inside route into upper stretch, got collared a furlong out and weakened through to the finish. WIND DANCER broke out a step at the start bumping OUT OF THE FOG, chased along the inside under coaxing from the three-eighths, spun two to three wide for home and made no impact. ALL APAULOGIES chased just off the inside under a ride from three furlongs out, angled three to four wide into upper stretch, made no impact. DEAD AIM stumbled badly at the start and lost the rider, got apprehended by the outrider after the finish, and walked off under his own power.
