RED MILLER coaxed from the gate, advanced after the break to establish narrow command just inside six furlongs to run, settled in hand along the inside under pressure from DEW to the outside, remained patiently handled and shook off that rival set down taking the inside route into upper stretch and coming under pressure now from the runner up, dug in under a drive as that rival latched on outside a furlong out, gamely fended off that foe to repel the challenge and inched away to the finish kept to task. SERGEANT CAPPS led briefly early on before chasing four then three wide from just off the leader, came under coaxing advancing on that rival at the five-sixteenths, swung five wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive latching on to the outside of the leader a furlong out but was ultimately rebuffed to the finish in the late stages. METATRON hustled from the gate, chased three to four wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths, angled out six to seven wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick. AERATE chased along the inside and then just off the inside under coaxing from the nine-sixteenths, took the inside route into upper stretch and offered up a mild bid. PARTY WITH SMARTY chased just off the inside until tucked inside half a mile from home, came under coaxing and tipped out three wide at the five-sixteenths, angled six wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid. DR. INSEL broke out at the start, chased four paths off the inside down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the turn coaxed along from the three-eighths marker, angled five wide at the head of the stretch, weakened in the drive. DEW pressed the pace from the two path under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, got shaken off spinning three wide at the top of the lane, tired in the stretch.

TIMAEUS was urged along on the outside, chased in the four path on the turn, moved closer late on that bend, turned into upper stretch under a drive, gained to make a bid outside of the runner-up in the final furlong and got up late under strong urging to prevail. MY MAN MATTY showed speed on the inside of a foe while tight against the rail, moved to a solo lead late on the backstretch, dictated terms in the two path on the turn, was asked in the three path into the stretch, came under a right-handed crop outside the furlong marker, was given one last pop of the crop outside the sixteenth-pole, led under a strong hand-ride until the final strides but was caught while clear for the place. HEAVYWEIGHT CHAMPS dropped back while hard ridden, saved ground on the turn, moved off the rail outside the quarter-pole, swung out to the six path into the stretch then moved further out in the drive and improved to just get the show. TORPEDO RUN was urged along towards the rear, went around the turn in the three path, moved out in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick then just missed the show. MASTERWORK was hustled from the gate then urged along off the pace, dropped from the two path to the inside early on the turn, saved ground into the stretch and lacked the needed response. RIDE UP was hustled from the gate then ridden along off the pace, dropped back while climbing leaving the backstretch, moved from the rail to the two path on the turn, was driven into upper stretch in the five path, drifted out nearing the furlong marker, drifted in late and failed to threaten. ALEAH ALEAH was hustled from the gate, moved in while showing speed, disputed the pace on the outside of a foe, dropped back late on the backstretch then moved out, chased in the three path on the turn, dropped back into upper stretch and tired. ACE IT stumbled badly at the start and unseated the rider then was walked off after being apprehended by an out-rider.

COMMUTED coaxed from the gate, dueled inside of REGISTER coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, shook off that rival and spun three wide into upper stretch, dug in under threat from flanking rivals and came inwards to the two path a furlong out to look the inside rival in the eye, dug in between foes to the sixteenth marker, had RANGER BATTALION come outwards slightly and brushed with that rival at that station, came inwards under a stiff right hand rein and a loose left rein, the rider making contact with RANGER BATTALION and pushing himself off as HOUSE UNITED came inwards filling the vacant space of COMMUTED through to the wire while never making contact with that rival, came in as a pair and forced RANGER BATTALION to check out along a closing rail strides from the finish and just held on to prevail. HOUSE UNITED four then three wide in pursuit, advanced on the top pair five-sixteenths from home and came under coaxing near the quarter pole, swung four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive stacked outside a pair of rivals heads apart for command through the stretch, came inwards filling the space given to him through to the finish under a right handed crop as that inside pair jostled along the inside, but never made any contact with COMMUTED through to the wire and just missed at the end. DREAMLIKE coaxed from the start, chased two to three wide coaxed along from three furlongs out, went seven wide into upper stretch, kicked on belatedly to the finish. RANGER BATTALION chased along the inside coming under encouragement near the quarter pole, spun three wide into upper stretch in behind COMMUTED and then straightened away in the two path near the three-sixteenths, rallied up the inside briefly with a lane between he and COMMUTED and had COMMUTED come over to look him in the eye a furlong out, dug in under a drive the innermost of a trio heads apart for command, came out under a left handed crop and brushed with COMMUTED a sixteenth out, had that foe come inwards under a stiff right hand drive as HOUSE UNITED continued to fill the empty space given him by COMMUTED and had the rider of COMMUTED push off with his elbow the first time and then got forced to check when impeded and squeezed out along the rail strides from the finish as COMMUTED came in again. HOT SPUN chased along the inside under a ride from the three-eighths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid. REGISTER dueled three then two wide coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, got shaken off and went six wide into upper stretch, tired. SWAGGISH chased four then three wide under coaxing from the three-eighths pole, went seven wide into upper stretch, tired. There was a Stewards' Inquiry into the stretch run as well as a claim of foul by the rider of RANGER BATTALION alleging interference against both COMMUTED and HOUSE UNITED in the stretch. After review, HOUSE UNITED was disqualified from second and placed fourth prior to the race being declared official.

ENLIGHTEN stalked the pace on the outside in the two to three path, was asked on the far turn, made a bid near the quarter-pole, dueled outside of the runner-up in the stretch and prevailed under strong urging. LIFE AND LIGHT went to the front, showed the way on the inside, was asked under threat near the quarter-pole, dueled determinedly inside of the winner in the stretch and missed while able to hold the place. RIGHT TO WIN (IRE) angled in early, saved ground on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, moved to from the two path to the four path while roused on the far turn, chased the top two in the stretch, gained on the foes late and just missed the place while able to get the show. STEADFAST RESOLVE saved ground on the first turn, was unhurried at the rear, moved from the two path to the four path while roused on the far turn, turned into the stretch in the six path and improved position for the last spot in the superfecta. JUST FOR LUCK angled in early, raced inside to the two path on the first turn, settled near the middle of the field, dropped from the two path to the rail early on the far turn then was roused on that bend and lacked the needed response. SASSY PRINCESS was well placed just off the pace on the inside, moved out while put to a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. HEATHGUARD rounded the first turn in the two path, was reserved towards the rear, raced in the three path while roused on the far turn, moved out over heels i in upper stretch, bumped with a rival inside the furlong marker and failed to impact. FUNNY UNCLE made light contact with a foe at the start, settled on the inside, moved to the two path midway through the far turn, was asked for his best in upper stretch and failed to rally. WAR OFFICER bobbled at the start then bumped lightly with a foe before dropping back, traveled around the first turn in the two path, settled outside without cover, went around the far turn in the four then five path, moved out some under a drive in upper stretch, bumped with an opponent inside the furlong marker and was taken in hand then failed to menace. FLAT ON tucked into the two path on the first turn, was rated just off the pace on the outside but with cover in front, moved from the two path to the three path while asked on the far turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and came up empty.
