NOBLE DYNASTY settled tracking the leader in closest aim from the two path, remained patiently handled until given a notch to work with five-sixteenths from home, got let out angled four then three wide straightened away into upper stretch and took over command, dug in under threat to the outside, repelled that rival and then gamely held from a late charging foe to score. QUIET POWER got spun four wide into the first turn by HONEY'S TO BLAME and in turn spun GULFY five wide, tucked to the inside soon after and tracked along the rail down the backstretch before making his way to the two path through the far turn coming under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, swung six wide into upper stretch, closed well outside and just missed on the wire for it all. HONEY'S TO BLAME spun three wide into the first turn and carried out a pair of rivals four and five wide into that bend, tucked to the two path soon after and tracked from mid pack, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide into upper stretch and dug in under a drive rallying willingly to the finish and was along for the show honors on the line. BRITISH INVASION (IRE) coaxed from the gate, settled tracking just off the inside from just off the pace, came under urging with five-sixteenths remaining, swung five wide into upper stretch, rallied offering up a bid to challenge the leader a furlong out, got

SLAPINTHEFACE dropped back in tight quarters between horses leaving the chute then angled in, moved from the rail to the two path late on the first turn, settled towards the rear, saved ground while roused on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch, rallied into the final furlong and closed with a rush to get up

late and prevail. CLEAR CONSCIENCE raced in the three path on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved from the two path to the four path on the far turn, shifted out some more while rallying in upper stretch, swapped back to his inside lead at the furlong marker, gained the advantage coming to the sixteenth-pole, fought with foes to the finish and was denied while just able to get the place. CABLE READY went around the opening bend in the three path, settled on the outside, was asked in the two path on the far turn, moved to the three path late on that bend, raced behind foes while in good striking range outside the eighth-pole then found clear space in front into the final furlong, closed well to make a bid between foes outside the sixteenth-pole, held a narrow advantage while head bobbing with the runner-up several strides from the wire and just missed while able to get the show. CLASSICIST a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, raced three then two wide through the first turn showing the way before settling into a comfortably rhythm in hand just off the inside down the backstretch, remained just off the rail through the far turn coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, got set down spinning three wide into upper stretch, went to a left handed crop at the three-sixteenths and shied out two paths to the eighth pole, then shied out again two paths nearing the sixteenth marker and brushed with his main danger at that station, dug in head to head to the finish brushing strides from the wire before holding on on the line to prevail. TUSCAN GOLD broke out at the start bumping STURDY, raced three then two wide through the first turn, chased three then two wide in closest aim of the leader, came under urging three furlongs out, swung four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive herding out slightly when CLASSICIST shied out near the eighth pole, dug in getting on near even terms and had that foe shy out a sixteenth out and was brushed at that station, fought on to the finish getting brushed jumps from the line and missed at the end when unable to go by. VALENTINIAN coaxed from the gate, chased just off the inside under a ride from the five-sixteenths, angled out six to seven wide into upper stretch, ran on through to the finish. MIKEALICIOUS broke out at the start bumping WAITLIST, raced just off the inside through the first turn and then four paths off the inside down the backstretch, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths when four to five wide through the far turn, continued five wide into upper stretch and offered up late foot. There was a Stewards' Inquiry into the stretch run as well as a claim of foul by the rider of TUSCAN GOLD alleging interference against CLASSICIST in the stretch. HEDGE THE RISK saved ground near the rear of the field remaining patiently handled until set down spinning just off the inside into upper stretch, angled in to the rail nearing the eighth pole and scraped the paint inside the leader inside that station rallying up the rail and was just up in the final jump to score, then got bumped in the next stride after the finish when LANDAUER came over. LANDAUER tracked the pace along the inside from mid pack, came under coaxing near the guarter pole and was let out taking the inside route into upper stretch, rallied to take command a furlong from home and was nailed on the wire. CATALINA CRUSH broke in at the start bumping PAPIAMENTO, dueled inside of KID KREESA from the get go, got let out spinning just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was collared a furlong out, ran on to preserve the show honors on the wire. UNION EXPRESS settled tracking the front just off the inside from mid pack, came under coaxing near the quarter pole, angled five wide into upper stretch, kept on to the finish. PAPIAMENTO got bumped at the start by CATALINA CRUSH, who broke inwards, settled two to three wide just off the pace, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, offered up a bid a furlong out, then flattened out in the late stages. MAGNI raced just off the inside through the first turn and then three to four wide thereafter, came under encouragement three furlongs out, swung six wide into upper stretch and stayed on one paced to the finish. SANDERSON lunged at the break, chased two to three wide coming under coaxing at the three-eighths marker, went seven wide into upper stretch and offered no response. MAYBERN away to an awkward start, raced four then three wide through the first turn, chased three wide down the backstretch before tucking inside three furlongs from home, went eight wide at the head of the stretch and made no impact. MY LIFE STORY tracked the pace along the inside coming under a ride at the five-sixteenths, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, weakened. YOUR MISSION coaxed from the gate, raced three wide through the first turn, chased three wide under coaxing from the three-eighths pole, went nine wide into upper stretch, made no impact. KID KREESA stumbled at the start, recovered to advance and duel from the two path with CATALINA CRUSH to his inside, remained patiently handled until set down angled four wide at the top of the stretch, then tired through to the finish.
