SWORE established the front and showed the way in hand just off the inside, tucked inside through the turn before making his way back to the two path through the straightaways when approaching the fences, jumped well to maintain his advantage while at times under close attendance from ZARAK THE BRAVE to the outside, remained patiently handled after clearing the final flight as WELSHMAN advanced outside also in hand in the flat, got displaced from command nearing the eighth pole and was roused at that station, dug in under a drive coming again to take back the front inside the final forty yards to the finish and prevailed gamely on the wire. WELSHMAN raced eager along the inside in pursuit from mid pack tossing his head at times under the restraint of the rider through the first four flights, tipped to the outside and was in the two path thereafter in the clear and settled, jumped early at fence five but jumped well the rest of the way, cleared the final flight and advanced on the front in hand through the far and final turn, took over command nearing the eighth pole and remained patiently handled until called upon at that station, dug in under a drive as the former leader came back on inside, fought gamely to the end but was ultimately collared inside the final forty yards and bested on the line. SWEET WILL (IRE) tracked the pace along the inside forwardly placed early on, dropped back to mid pack and then jumped late at fences six and seven losing some more ground, came under coaxing after clearing the final fence, advanced in the flat through the final turn and offered up a mild kick to secure the show honors. HIDDEN PATH settled just off the inside near the rear of the field, jumped well to keep pace with the front, came under encouragement after clearing the final flight and offered up a mild bid. BEE WELL settled tracking the leader along the inside from just off the pace, jumped well to maintain his position, came under urging after the final fence and weakened in the late stages. ZARAK THE BRAVE (FR) attended the leader to the outside two to three wide jumping well to accompany that rival through to the final flight, came under encouragement inside that station and faded through the final turn, then weakened in the stretch. TRAVESURAS settled tracking the front just off the inside from just off the pace, jumped well to maintain position, came under a ride once in the flat and retreated through the final turn, tired, and was eased home to the finish. CAMELISED (GB) saved ground at the tail of the field, jumped late at flight seven, came under urging approaching the ninth fence, trailed and was eased home to the wire.

SHE'S COMPLICATED was grabbed with the right-rein shortly after the start and pulled out, stalked the pace on the outside, was asked some leaving the backstretch, vied in the three then four path on the turn, took the lead at the quarter-pole then shook clear in upper stretch, was given one light tap of a left-handed crop outside the furlong marker, drew away under a solid hand-ride into the final seventy yards then was eased up while much the best. SPIRIT OF ESTHER came away in good order then showed clear early, set the pace with some company to her outside, vied in the two path while asked on the turn, lost the lead to the winner at the quarter-pole and proved no match while clear for the place. TOXIC GIRL broke out then was corrected by the rider, settled off the pace, was urged along late on the backstretch, dropped back into the turn, saved ground on that bend, moved off the rail outside the quarter-pole, spun into the stretch under the crop and tired while best of the rest. CHA CHA WREN broke out and bumped hard with a foe, dropped in towards the rear early, was urged along passing the nine-sixteenths pole, moved from the two path to the four path on the turn, turned into the stretch in the five path and failed to threaten. YO LEVEN settled on the outside, dropped back leaving the backstretch, was urged along in the three path on the turn and came up empty. LUCKY AND GORGEOUS was bumped at the start, settled towards the rear, came under urging just inside the three-quarter pole, moved from the two path to the rail on the turn and was no factor. POLITICAL SPIN was bumped hard at the start and forced out into another foe, settled at the rear, moved out under urging outside the five-eighths pole, went around the turn in the four path and also was no factor.

SUNSHINE LILY coaxed from the gate, chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking four then three wide through the turn coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, took brief command at that station and swung seven to eight wide into upper stretch and was headed for the front straightened away for home, dug in under a drive dueling through the stretch to the finish and got the nod on the wire. RED VELVET CAKE struck the near side stall at the start when getting away awkward, raced four paths off the inside down the backstretch in closest aim of the leader, tucked three then two wide and took over command when placed to urging with five-sixteenths to go, got headed swinging six wide into upper stretch, took back the front straightened away, dug in dueling through the stretch to the finish, came out a path or two to look her main danger in the eye, then lost the bob on the line. PATIENCE N GRACE chased six paths off the inside down the backstretch and then four wide through the turn coming under encouragement near the quarter pole, went eight to nine wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. BODEGAS two to three wide in pursuit, came under coaxing three furlongs out, angled five wide into upper stretch, weakened in the drive. KATIE KING stumbled badly at the start and recovered outwards bumping GIULIANA'S DREAM, chased along the inside under a ride from the three-eighths marker, took the inside route into upper stretch and made no impact. SUGAR RIDE coaxed from the gate, chased four to five wide under urging from the three-eighths pole, went seven to eight wide into upper stretch and made no impact. BROKEALLTHERULES coaxed from the start, chased just off the inside under urging from the seven-sixteenths, spun three wide into upper stretch, tired. GIULIANA'S DREAM got bumped at the start by KATIE KING, who recovered inwards from a stumble, showed the way in hand along the inside, yielded the front with five-sixteenths to run, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and faltered in the drive.

OAT COUTOUR settled at the rear in the two path, was roused on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and finished willingly to just miss the place while narrowly up for the show.
