READY SET TWIRL chased two to three wide under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, angled five wide into upper stretch, kept on to the finish but was outkicked to the end.

INSUBORDINATION (IRE) got bumped in a chain of bumps by COUSIN ED and in turn bumped BLOWN COVER, chased along the inside patiently handled until called upon swinging three wide at the top of the stretch, then weakened in the late stages. DANCING BEAR broke out at the start and was corrected, cut the pace along the inside under prompting from NANO MAN to the outside, cut the corner roused into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was collared a furlong out, then weakened through to the wire.
