WHITTINGTON PARK raced in the three path on the first turn, settled well back under some urging, moved from the two path to the four path while getting closer on the far turn, turned into the stretch in the seven path, rallied outside to get the lead outside the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under strong urging. WYNSTOCK broke at the rear of the field, rounded the first turn in the two path, settled at the rear under some urging, moved from the three path to the five path while getting closer on the far turn, spun into the stretch in the nine path, rallied on the far outside, closed strongly to make a bid outside the sixteenth-pole but missed while clear for the place. MR. HELLO BEAUTY chased along the inside early on before tipping to the three path, continued three wide through the turn coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, went eight wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive issuing a challenge inside the final furlong, had OFF SCRIPT come outwards to look her in the eye and was bumped nearing the sixteenth pole and again when seizing command seventy yards from the finish and prevailed by a neck on the wire. OFF SCRIPT coaxed from the gate, raced five paths off the inside in closest aim of the leader, tucked three wide into the turn and advanced to take command five-sixteenths from home, swung four wide into upper stretch, inched away under a drive to the eighth pole, got directed out to look her main danger in the eye and bumped that rival just outside the sixteenth pole and again seventy yards from the finish when headed for command, ran on clear for the place honors. LADY DELILAH coaxed from the gate, chased three paths off the rail down the backstretch before tucking along the inside through the turn coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, angled five wide into upper stretch, kept on to procure the show honors. IVERAGH got bumped at the start by A. P. SLINGSHOT and in turn bumped CHARMEUSE, chased five then four wide under urging nearing the quarter pole, went seven wide into upper stretch offering up a bid, then weakened in the late stages. NIGHT JASMINE chased just off the inside and then along the inside under light coaxing from the seven-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, weakened in the late going. A. P. SLINGSHOT broke in at the start bumping IVERAGH into CHARMEUSE, showed the way in hand four then three wide down the backstretch before tucking to the two path through the turn coming under increasing pressure from OFF SCRIPT to the outside, got placed to urging when headed for command at the five-sixteenths, went three wide into upper stretch and tired. CHARMEUSE got bumped at the start by IVERAGH due to pressure from the aforement
