HOURS IN A DAY broke out at the start bumping FIRST TRUMPET, chased two to three wide under a ride from the three-eighths marker, went seven to eight wide into upper stretch, rallied to issue a challenge inside the final furlong and seized command near the sixteenth pole, then edged clear to the finish kept busy to the end. JUDGE DAVIS dropped to the inside on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, raced inside for most of the far turn then moved to the two path,

shifted to the four path while roused into upper stretch, chased into the final furlong, gained to make a bid coming to the sixteenth-pole and got under strong handling to prevail. DEAR DAD went to the front, showed the way in the two path with a clear advantage, was asked near the quarter-pole then came under a drive in upper stretch, lost the advantage outside the eighth-pole, fought on gamely in the final furlong but missed while just able to get the place.
