BUEN SAMARITANO raced in close, rallied three wide on the turn, dueled three across, came in near the sixteenth pole, impeded I JUST DON'T NO and prevailed in a game effort. I JUST DON'T NO pressed the pace, challenged for the lead on the turn, dueled between horses, was impeded and checked near the sixteenth pole and dropped back. ONE FAST MIDDIE set a pressured pace, responded to duel inside through the stretch and was outfinished in a game effort. JAR was off slowly, showed brief speed only and was not urged through the stretch. Following a stewards' inquiry and a rider's objection, BUEN SAMARITANO was disqualified and placed third for causing interference in the stretch.
