COASTLAND quickly established the front and settled into a good rhythm, responded when set down at the top of the stretch under a challenge from SHOWTIME BOY approaching the quarter pole, held that rival at bay down the stretch, and just lasted. SHOWTIME BOY broke well, hustled to stay close up to COASTLAND to the turn, launched a bid from the five-sixteenths marker, loomed a big threat at the top of the stretch while racing on the left lead, gradually cut the margin but came up short in the end, lugging in under right-handed urging. ROCKET LAUNCHER broke outward at the start, made hard contact with SAMURAI WAY and was slow away, settled in the middle of the compact field, was put into a drive from the seven-sixteenths marker but could do no more than chase the top pair into the stretch and lacked a winning kick. ENTICED BY CHANCE was outrun down the backstretch, then started to gradually advance through the turn but could not find the needed late response. SAMURAI WAY knocked off-stride following a bump from ROCKET LAUNCHER at the start, with the rider nearly coming off, chased from the back through the early running, then was being coaxed along passing the half-mile pole, struggled to keep up midway through the turn, and was not a factor in the stretch run.

MENTY B took command the break and established the pace while being pressed by a pair of rivals to the outside, was set down near the quarter pole, shook free of both pursuers, responded to strong handling and intermittent urging, and drew clear in the final furlong. CLASSIC TIRAMISU was slow into stride then moved up to join the pace three wide near the half-mile pole, maintained that position through the turn, then was set down at the top of the stretch, hung a bit racing on the left lead and settled for second. TONI MARIE hustled away, then was taken in hand, allowing MENTY B to dictate the fractions, pressed the issue to the turn, then came under a ride with three furlongs to run, loomed to mid-stretch, then flattened out. OURAY DREAMIN walked out of the gate, refused to engage, spotted the field a massive head start, made up ground in the late stages but was never a factor.

LAUGH A LOT seized the early lead, then proceeded to dictate very slow early fractions, easily shook off a challenge from CLEVELAND POWER at the five-sixteenths marker, then opened up in the stretch, won well clear under a hand ride. OBI KENOBI settled off the pace racing two-wide, responded when set down at the quarter pole, and produced a good stretch rally to gain the place with no chance to catch the winner. CLEVELAND POWER stalked LAUGH A LOT to the far turn, made a try for the lead midway on the turn but could not keep up when that rival quickened away, weakened in the stretch, and lost the place. CANNON MAN was a little slow into stride, then moved up to be close to the leaders through the first turn, then backed off a bit down the backstretch, came under a ride as the pace quickened heading into the far turn, but could not keep up. ROAD TO MUSIC CITY stumbled badly at the start, trailed throughout, then made an unsuccessful bid to improve a placing in the final yards.

SIR PAYSALOT was pushed from the break to get a forward position, and made the front end after racing a furlong, dug in under a threat from a pair of rivals to the outside at the top of the stretch, finished up well under steady handling and intermittent urging, and held clear to the finish. ONE DESTINATION broke well, then was held up behind the early pace, moved out to the three path on the turn, launched a bid from the five-sixteenths marker, had some trouble with the lead change at the top of the stretch, finished well once straightened, but ran out of time to catch the winner. BABALO'S BOY broke best, led through the initial stages, then ceded the front to SIR PAYSALOT, continued in a stalking position through the turn, made a challenge for the lead approaching the quarter pole, was turned away by that rival, then began to wander about in mid-stretch and was outfinished. MADCAP was very slow to get into stride, chased from far behind and never menaced. DIRTY JOKE ducked in after the start, then bore in again once straightened out, dropped far behind and was never a factor.

CEEDEE unhurried from the break and settled at the back of the strung-out field, navigated a tricky path through the far turn, then was blocked in upper stretch while full of run, altered course to the outside and surged when clear to be up in time. FLOWERY PATH pulled to the lead with the rider doing his best to temper the pace, committed to go on from the three-furlong pole, led the field into the stretch, responded when set down in the stretch, and just failed to last. TIDAL TACTICS hopped at the start, then tracked mid-pack, launched a rally with three furlongs to run, bid four-wide at the top of the stretch, finished up well under handling and intermittent urging but came up short in a blanket finish. CAPTIVE STAR settled inside near the back, advanced through the far turn, put in a good finish to be second with an aim on the leader with a furlong to run, but got passed by a pair of fast-closing rivals in the final jumps. STATEMENT MADE tracked the early leader from between horses, kept on well through the lane but was outfinished. SCARY PROPOSITION pulled on the rider through the early stages, made a mild middle move to reach contention on the far turn but was not quite good enough in the final furlong. EASTERN

SUNRISE took a light bump and was forced inward by SYLLABUS at the start, raced inside of the tracking trio, moved up to go after the leader midway on the last turn but was outkicked in the final furlong. SYLLABUS veered into EASTERN SUNRISE at the start, saved ground throughout, moved up from well behind through the far turn, finished willingly but outkicked in the late stages. MY AMY raced near the back of the field, saved ground, and was unable to summon a late bid. STEAL THE DEAL went four wide through the first turn then raced three-wide in the middle of the pack and lacked a rally. HUIXTLA tracked three-wide with the second flight, started to lose ground heading into the far turn, retreated and was not involved late. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

BELLA ALESSIA was off a step slow then rushed up to be forwardly placed behind the leaders, bided time while keeping to the inside through the last turn, tipped out to the three path at the furlong pole, got first run and went clear to the wire. FOREVER HOPEFUL was hustled away from the gate but ceded the early lead and settled along the rail, bided time to the three furlong pole, then responded when set down, swung four to five wide into the stretch, finished well on the outside of the main pack, and got up for second in the final yards. RADIANCE settled in mid-pack, two deep through the first half-mile, launched a bid after passing the three-furlong pole, was finishing well but in some traffic in mid-stretch, surged through a narrow opening late and gained the third spot. FUN LOVING raced four wide in the middle of the pack through the early stages, moved up to challenge the leaders approaching the three-furlong pole, loomed in upper stretch but had some trouble changing leads and lost some momentum that may have cost a placing. MAURYA mutually bumped with LAUREN'S DREAM at the start, sent forward from the break, made the front before the first turn and went a length or two clear heading down the backstretch, turned for home with a slight lead, ran on well with good effort, but was outfinished in the final yards. LAUREN'S DREAM reluctant to load, came together with MAURYA after the break, then moved up to put some pressure on MAURYA down the backstretch and into the far turn, battled between horses gamely down the stretch and weakened a bit in the final yards. RAINBOW RANIA was very slow to begin, then coaxed forward to join the main pack at the back, stayed on the rail, and finished up well and was gaining ground late but was not quite good enough. SCREAMING MIMI allowed to settle at the back, but never fired. MO BREEZY raced mid-pack for the first half-mile, tried to advance late down the backstretch but encountered some traffic, weakened late on the far turn, and had little to offer in the stretch.
