SARAH JANE , rated along the inner rail down the backstretch, began to pick it up leaving the turn, remained on her left lead in the stretch, moved to the two path near the sixteenth pole and took the lead approaching the finish. WHISKEY DIAMOND accelerated to a clear lead soon after the break, was snugly in hand along the inner rail down the backstretch, stayed along the rail through the stretch and tired late. SAVESOMEFORME entered the turn in the two path between horses and failed to rally. ROCKY CHANNEL lunged at the break, rushed up outside horses mid way down the backstretch, stayed three deep on the turn, failed to switch to her right lead in the stretch and came up empty.

PINEDALE , rated down the backstretch, appeared to be attempting to get out entering the turn, was kept in the two path around the bend, split horses inside the eighth pole to take the lead then held sway under steady handling. J W RUCKUS chased the pace outside CENTRIFUGAL FORCE, floated to the four path turning for home, bid for the lead in mid stretch and continued gamely. MIKIE O'PRADO stumbled badly at the break, advanced along the inner rail to reach a striking position in mid stretch and flattened out. CENTRIFUGAL FORCE , clear soon after the start, set the pace in the two path around the turn, remained in the two path in the stretch and weakened.

DANCE SOME MO , reluctant to load into the starting gate, circled the first turn four deep, advanced three wide in hand leaving the far turn, secured command in upper stretch and drew off while ridden out. RAISON KARTER , under urging along the inner rail entering the far turn, gained the lead approaching the stretch, was overtaken in upper stretch, weakened and held the place. FROSTY THE SOLDIER made the early lead, raced in the two path between the top pair the far turn, swung wide in upper stretch and faded. ROAD MINISTER broke slowly, was outrun and circled the far turn three wide. LONG SHORTS , shuffled back on the first turn, raced along the rail in the stretch and gave way.
