CHECK THE FACTS , eased outside approaching the half mile pole, circled the turn three wide, floated to the four path turning for home, remained on his left lead, closed steadily and was up in deep stretch. SHANGHAI PRINCE , outside PARTY POOPER down the backstretch and around the turn, gained the lead in the three path in upper stretch, finished well but was not quite good enough. PARTY POOPER quickly went clear, saved ground on the turn, raced in the two path in the stretch and weakened the final furlong. RED HEAD KID remained along the inner rail throughout, chased the pace and failed to rally. HONOR THE D , kept wide on the turn, was outrun. This race was originally hand timed and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

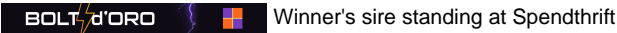

LUMIERE stalked the pace outside JABRAN, travelled the turn three wide, kicked in late, took the lead approaching the finish and drove clear. JABRAN made the early lead, was kept in the two path around the turn, was still clear in mid stretch and gave way grudgingly. COMMANDO JOE bumped with BASSCOAT at the start, advanced along the inner rail on the turn and weakened in the drive. BASSCOAT , steadied in tight quarters after bumping with COMMANDO JOE leaving the starting gate, raced four wide on the turn and was not a facor. BETTERING , not far off the pace on the backstretch, stayed near the inner rail and steadily retreated the final half mile. ROGER MCQUEEN , unhurried early, raced near the inner rail on the turn and failed to be a factor.
