LYLA'S LUCKY BOY bore out at the start, between horses early, went clear mid way on the backstretch, stayed in the two path around the turn, opened up in upper stretch and held sway under steady handling. PRAY FOR THE BEAR saved ground on the turn and rallied. ROJO SKY , forced out after hopping at the start, chased the leader while three wide and flattened out. IMPROBABLE CAUSE broke slowly, circled the turn three wide and came up empty in the stretch. MIDNIGHT NOIR showed brief speed near the inner rail in the opening furlong, swung wide in mid stretch and lacked the needed rally. TUFF HEART broke slowly, eased out leaving the backstretch, circled the turn three wide and was outrun.
