# Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

HAPPY HAPPY DAY (ARG), deftly taken to the inner rail approaching the first turn, remained along the rail, found room inside DRIFTWOOD through the stretch and was up in the drive. DRIFTWOOD set the pace near the rail, raced in the two path in the stretch and gave way grudgingly. AGENT CREED, a forward factor along the inner rail, eased out to the three path leaving the far turn and flattened out. AUTHORITARIAN, well placed in the two path between horses the far turn, swung to the four path in mid stretch for clear room and failed to rally. MAYNARD chased the pace, raced in the two path the far turn, was inside horses in the stretch and weakened. HOMETOWN HERO raced along the inner rail in the stretch and lacked a rally. ANCHOR MANNE, three wide the first turn, chased the pace, floated four deep entering the stretch and weakened. PILKINGTON broke slowly, circled the first turn three wide, the far turn four wide and was not a factor.
