MOTOR CITY MENACE tucked in behind the leaders on the first turn, shifted to the inside for the run down the backstretch, raced with the trio tracking well behind the dueling leaders, then launched an inside bid from the five-sixteenths marker, chased VENEZUELAN FAITH down the stretch, and got up in the final yards. VENEZUELAN FAITH showed good speed from the break, pressed NERVANA under a bit of a hold through moderate early fractions, took command after passing the three-furlong pole, opened up a clear lead in upper stretch, but was caught in the final yards. MOON CHARGER slow early to be well off the leaders at the rear of the field, commenced a steady, long drive on the turn and finished with a late gain along the inside to be up for the show. MACLIN raced three wide in the tracking group, was often having to be coaxed along to maintain position, went into a drive near the seven-sixteenths marker, went three wide through the far turn, then swung five-wide into the stretch but was unable to generate a winning kick in the lane. ICONIC ROCK too a slight hop at the start and was off a step slow, settled in the middle of the pack one path off the rail, struggled to keep pace after passing the half-mile pole, and lacked a rally. NERVANA made the front and attempted to slow down the pace, had VENEZUELAN FAITH pressing the issue to the outside but was able to set modest splits, gave way with three furlongs to run, was kept to task but had little to offer in the late stages, and faded.

DESTINY'S DARLING stalked WILDCAT DREAM through the early stages before taking command with three furlongs to run, opened up in the stretch under urging and held off a fast-closing rival on the inside to prevail despite drifting out to the middle of the track in the final yards. EMERSON'S DREAM came out of the gate awkwardly and was slow into stride, trailed well behind the field early, then made a furious late bid up the rail but came up short. CANA GRIS tracked two-deep behind the early pace, launched a bid from the five-sixteenths marker but flattened out in upper stretch. WILDCAT DREAM hustled from the break, made the front into the first turn, went a length or two clear down the backstretch with the rider trying his best to temper the pace, gave way readily approaching the quarter pole, then was outfinished in the late stages. LONG BLACK VEIL lacked any early speed and raced near the back of the pack four to five wide with only EMERSON'S DREAM behind, did not respond when asked to pick up the pace on the far turn, and was unable to improve in the late stages. MARKET OF STOCKS settled mid-pack then lacked a rally, finishing one-paced in the stretch.

TWO TWENTY TWO was away well, dueled outside of SHELTOWEES BLING down the backstretch and through the turn always traveling well, came into the stretch under confident handling, then drew off under a hand ride. SOUP TODAY tracked two-wide close up racing down the backstretch, bid three-wide leaving the quarter pole, took a bump from SHELTOWEES BLING in mid-stretch, was unable to get to the winner, but won the race for the second prize. SHELTOWEES BLING dueled inside of TWO TWENTY TWO through the turn, tried to fight back when that rival took the lead in upper stretch, had trouble changing leads through the stretch, was outfinished, and had to settle for the minor award. SCIOTO was a little slow to get going, then got into a good rhythm after passing the half-mile pole, chased the leaders through the turn, racing on the inside, had some trouble changing leads at the top of the stretch, and flattened out some in mid-stretch. TRIANGULO ROJO stumbled badly at the start, nearly losing the rider, was far behind early, but kept to task and beat one rival to the finish line. MONEY MAGIC broke well, was briefly close up in the initial stages, then was in chase mode from the half-mile pole, lost ground on the turn, and was not a factor in the stretch.

ROAD TO MUSIC CITY was pushed away from the gate to get a forward position but ceded the front, tracked well behind the dueling leaders, then crept close approaching the far turn, bid three-wide under a drive from the quarter pole, battled outside of a couple of rivals down the stretch and edged ahead in the final yards and just held clear from a resurgent MR. BALI near the wire. MR. BALI settled inside at the back through the early stages, started to move forward leaving the half, made a mild advance through the turn, then slipped through an opening along the rail and took the lead at the top of the stretch, battled gamely with a pair of rivals to the outside, only to come up short in the end. MAN'S CHOICE dueled outside of MAN'S CHOICE early, assumed the lead, leaving the half-mile pole, opened up through the turn, dug in under challenges to the inside and outside, steadied in tight quarters near the finish, and lost all chance. GOT ZIP raced three wide with the trailing group, launched a three-wide bid with three furlongs to run, lugged in down the stretch, and faltered. NO PROOF stalked the pacesetters through the early stages, then moved up to vied for the lead three-deep at the half-mile pole, dueled gamely with RED SHAHEEN the rest of the way but could not get by that one until the last jump. RED SHAHEEN pressed the early pace before assuing the lead after passing the half-mile pole, was immediately taken on by a pair of rivals heading into the far turn, held sway then had a short lead turning for home, dueled with NO PROOF gamely for the length of the stretch and led every jump but the last. COACH PETRO settled back early, made a three-wide sweeping move through the far turn to loom a big threat in upper stretch, continued to run on under steady handling, but came up a head short at the finish. SUCCESSION GOLD settled well off the pace early, moved up to join the main back late on the backstretch, bid three wide through the far turn, finished up well but had trouble changing leads and was outfinished in the final furlong. TIVERTON raced well behind the pace, then lacked a finish. RYNO WRECKER settled inside close up, became boxed in on the far turn, finished with some interest but was outkicked in the final yards. CHENTI raced close up to the far turn, then tired in the stretch. CRIMINAL DEFENSE unhurried, showed no interest early on, and was never a factor. JACKSON'S ROAR dueled for a little more than a half-mile, then steadily retreated. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

SHRINER broke well, showed good speed to grab the lead early, got some pressure from VINDICATED TIGER early on but was always traveling well in-hand, drew away when roused in the stretch, and widened the margin in the final furlong. VINDICATED TIGER raced just off the flank of SHRINER through the early stages, started to struggle to keep up with that rival midway on the turn, was no match in the stretch, but finished up well clear of the next horse. BENITO brushed with LYLA'S LUCKY BOY at the start, was slow early to be well off the leaders at the rear of the field, commenced a steady, long drive on the turn, and finished with a late gain along the inside to gain the show. HOWARD'S GRIT broke well, chased pace from mid-pack, got an inside run through the turn, but was unable to summon a rally. WEGOTJACKSBACK was allowed to settle after the break, raced near the rear of the field, made a mild advance through the turn, but flattened out in the stretch. DOOQ threw the head up at the start, broke last then rushed up into contention to be in third position by the five-eighths pole, was under a drive from the three-furlong pole but weakened late on the turn and was not a factor in the stretch run. HECTOR B raced briefly between horses in the tracking group but dropped out early and had nothing to offer late. ZIGGZAPPA bobbed at the start, was allowed to settle at the rear of the main pack through the early running, steadily advanced late on the backstretch run and through the far turn, tipped out four-wide to bid for the lead at the top of the stretch, and finished up best to win going away. COUNCILWOMAN JILLY settled mid-pack, launched a three-wide bid with three furlongs to run, came four-wide into the stretch, loomed a threat near the fulong grounds but found the winner too much in the late stages. DIFFERENTLY bumped with RYE SMILE at the start but raced forwardly through the first turn, then tracked close up inside down the backstretch, had to wait for racing room late on the far turn, and finished with good energy when clear. CEEBEE reserved early, saved ground, encountered some traffic at the head of the stretch, then produced a good late run but was too late. PEACOCK ROAD tracked mid-pack and finished evenly. KICK OUT THE JAMS void of speed early, bid five or six wide through the far turn and into the stretch but was unable to make an impact. ISA LEI hustled from the break, made the front on the first turn and led the field through the first half-mile, got pressure along the way from LADY HAMILTON, came into the stretch with a short lead but gave way readily before mid-stretch. LADY HAMILTON came away well and pressed the early pace two-deep, remained in contention to the stretch, then weakened in a sea of challengers. JACK'S SUMMER raced close up two to three wide to the far turn,

then came up empty in the stretch. RYE SMILE bumped with DIFFERENTLY at the start, pulled to be up with the leaders exiting the first turn, was taken back down the backstretch, then tried to rally on the far turn, came under pressure after passing the quarter pole, and was outrun in the stretch.
