TOUGH CAT off bit slow, settled while never far back then was in a bit tight nearing the quarter marker, angled out approaching mid-stretch, surged in deep stretch and just missed for the win, while besting the rest. TAP THE WIND pressed the pace from the outside, vied upper stretch, yielded to the top pair past the furlong grounds and was a clear third. GONE WILD broke alertly and assumed early command, set the pace to upper stretch, was overtaken nearing the furlong marker and faded in the drive.

KING OF SWORDS tracked early pace, bid two to three wide to upper stretch, drew to a clear lead inside of the furlong pole, dug in to the final sixteenth then was nailed for the win in the final strides and bested the rest. GO COLLECTOR took back off of the early pace, saved ground into the turn, lacked a final kick in the stretch and was a clear third. HEY BATTER BATTER rated early, coaxed three to four wide to quarter, passed tired foes in the lane. SPINNING SPIRIT tracked outside, gain three wide to quarter marker, weakened stretch. GIGGITY unhurried early, saved ground to stretch, no late response. CORELLIA showed speed and assumed early command, sprinted clear and set pace to quarter marker, was overtaken to upper stretch and faded in the drive.
