FEELTHEBEAT broke sharp, but settled in, well back from the leaders in the second flight, made a steady gain down the backstretch and closed fast in the stretch drive to win easily, overtaking the leader in late stretch. BOBBY'S GIFT stalked the pace early, then dueled for the lead from the backstretch, drawing clear of the field around the turn, but was second best, being overtaken by the eventual winner near the wire. TAKE CHARGE D'ORO broke slow from the inside, moved up to the middle of the second flight, angled out down the lane, offering a bid to get up for show. BASSCOAT trailed early, saving ground and making a mild bid up the rail. PINEDALE was mid pack on the outside, then offered a mild bid and passed tiring rivals. CASANOVA KITTEN raced in the second flight, on the outside and well back from the leaders and had no late run. JARLIAN made the early lead and dueled down the backstretch but gave way around the turn and faded.
