

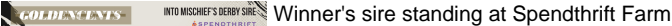

THE LITTLE SULTANA broke alertly to take command from the gate, opened a clear lead down the backstretch, widened the advantage turning for home and was unchallenged in the lane. UNFAITHFUL ROSE prompted the pace early, settled off the leaders down the backstretch, commenced a steady rally midway on the turn and was up for the place in deep stretch. CONSTANT CHATTER stalked the pace racing up from between rivals into the turn, mounted a bid around the bend, could not gain on the winner, chased that one down the lane and lost the place late s best of the rest. FLAMING MAMA broke sharply outward to bump and crowd rival to her outside, staightened away to be reserved off the pace, circled seven wide turning for home and put in a mild rally down the stretch. LADY VIRAGO leaned in bumping rival leaving the gate, raced up two wide to track the pace into the turn and lacked a closing bid going evenly. A ROSE FOR SKYLER went evenly posing no threat. WORKIN THE ROOM broke well wide to drop to the rear of the field and was not a factor. LA HEROICA bumped and squeezed back at the start, rushed up the fence to contention into the turn and gave way on the bend having been used up.
