POWER PARTY raced to prompt the early lead into the first turn, took command setting a pressured pace after a quarter, dueled down the backside, led into the far turn, surrendered the lead to the runner-up nearing the quarter pole and persevered coming back gamely along the fence in the final sixteenth to prevail. WRECK IT RUBY was rank down the stretch for the first time tugging against rider restraint, angled out to the clear onto the backstretch, pulled up four wide to press the pace, rallied to the lead on the turn, dueled through the stretch with the stubborn winner and was outkicked late settling to be second best. PARTLY SUNNY tracked the leaders from the fence for three-quarters to be well placed, drifted out coming for home and lacked a closing kick in the lane. RACHEL'S KID reserved off the pace racing mid-pack, saved ground on the final bend and showed good late interest ot be best of the rest. BLOOMIN HEART rated in mid-pack to the head of the lane, angled five wide for the drive and finished with a mild rally in the lane. DYNAMO'S CODE broke slow to be the trailer and made steady progress passed weaker rivals late to split the field. WILLFUL ROSE raced along the inside down the stretch the first time, hit the rail into the first turn in tight quarters, and failed to menace from there upon recovering. TONE OF SILENCE missed the break to be several lengths behind, circled up on the first turn to be with the pack and was never a threat passing tiring rivals in the lane. GUSSY was the early pacesetter into the first turn, pressed the pace to the far turn and came up empty. BONGOS (IRE) rushed up to contention angling to the rail into the turn, crowded rival on the bend and dropped back through the field tiring as the race progressed.
