CAJUN GAL took early command, set a modest pace to the half-mile marker, lost the lead to upper stretch, fought back and came again to re-take the lead into the final sixteenth, gamely dug in in late and held over the oncoming runner-up. LADIES LOVE CASH settled to the backstretch, roused three wide along the far turn, made a sustained rally from the outside through the lane, closed fast in deep stretch and just missed for the win, while getting up in time for the place. BAYTOWN MUNNY forwardly placed to begin, tracked the modest pace to the backstretch, went up to vie for the lead from the rail nearing the quarter marker, took command to upper stretch then led at the furlong grounds, couldn't hold off the leading pair into the final sixteenth and was outfinished for the win and place. BIZY DREAMIN off a step slow to begin, recovered and was forwardly placed while two to three wide heading into the backstretch, lost ground into the far turn, couldn't muster the needed response in the stretch drive and weakened. PERMANENT PROBLEM took back into the first turn and settled outside of rivals to the backstretch, trailed into the far turn and did not factor in the stretch drive. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

SCIOTO close up to the early pace then rated nicely approaching the turn, bid four wide to upper stretch, took command at the furlong marker, kicked clear to the final sixteenth and was ridden out to the wire. SILVER IS A GIFT tracked the early pace while saving ground, was well placed to the turn, came in tight while along the rail nearing the top of the lane then lacked room into upper stretch, found a seam along the inside into the final sixteenth, couldn't impact the winner late and held well for the place. SHELTOWEES BLING caught a bit in tight between foes leaving the gate, went up to contest the early pace three wide, pressed to the quarter marker and vied for the lead three deep into upper stretch, couldn't keep pace with the winner into the final furlong then was outfinished for the place, while holding safely for the show. SMOOTH WHISKEY broke alertly then took back and trailed early on, roused four to five wide to upper stretch, lacked the needed response to the final sixteenth and was outkicked for the minor awards. MONEY MAGIC showed speed from the gate and took early command, set a pressured pace from the two path nearing the quarter marker, overtaken to upper stretch, couldn't find more to the final sixteenth and gave way. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

DAVE DID IT disputed the early pace from the outside of NOT LIKE US, dueled that rival to the quarter marker, took command and shook free to upper stretch, drew away while kept to task into the final sixteenth then was geared down approaching the wire. MOST PROBABLE forwardly placed away from the gate then took back, trailed into the turn, re-rallied along the inside to upper stretch, angled out then could not impact the winner into the final sixteenth but bested the rest. FIRESTORM DANCER off slow and unhurried to begin, settled in the two path heading to the turn, swung to the three path to upper stretch, couldn't impact the top pair into the lane but kept on to be a clear third. NOT LIKE US showed good early speed from the gate and disputed the pace from the inside, dueled inside of DAVE DID IT into the turn, battled into the lane then was turned away nearing the furlong pole, couldn't find more to the final sixteenth and weakened. MEEKO hopped at the break and was last away from the start, settled while widest approaching the turn, got crowded a bit nearing the quarter marker and floated to the four path nearing that station, swung widest to upper stretch and failed to threaten late. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

SPRING SPINNING crowded then squeezed at the start and off slowly, settled off of the early pace, gained ground nearing the quarter marker then angled widest to upper stretch, responded into the final furlong, wore down foes in deep stretch and got up in the final jump to prevail. LADY LANCER came in at the start and crowded inner rivals, was forwardly placed to begin then tracked the early pace from the second flight, bid three wide at the quarter marker, rallied to the furlong pole and vied for the lead to the final sixteenth, took a narrow advantage in deep stretch, was nailed on the wire for the win and held for the place in a game runner-up effort. SISTERLITHIC sent to vie for the early lead, took command and set the pace from the inside heading into the turn, led into upper stretch then dug in passing the furlong pole, stubbornly battled to the final sixteenth, was outfinished for the win and place in deep stretch and was well clear of the rest for the show honors. MOTHER VOLGA broke out at the start and bothered outer rivals, was forwardly placed in the early stages then tracked the pace from the inside approaching the turn, moved to the two path along the turn and chased to the quarter pole, lacked the needed response to upper stretch and weakened in the final furlong. QUEEN LEXI pinched at the start and spotted the field to begin, trailed to the turn, was last to upper stretch and did not factor. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
