ORBI ONE close up to the early pace, roused three wide nearing the quarter marker, shifted to the four path for the stretch drive, wore down foes into the final sixteenth and got up in time for a determined win. EGYPTIAN KING off slow to begin, settled to the backstretch, made a four then five wide rally into the far turn, responded well in the stretch and just missed for the win, while just getting up in time for the place. VENEZUELAN FAITH settled early then made a rail middle move heading to the half-mile marker, vied for the lead to the far turn, took command to upper stretch and dug in at the furlong grounds, fought gamely to deep stretch and was outfinished in the final strides, while just holding for third. MANSION PARTY broke alertly and set a moderate pace while off of the rail, came under pressure at the quarter marker, fought on through the lane and was outfinished in a good effort. ICONIC ROCK tracked the early pace from the outside, well placed while four wide to the half-mile marker, lost position nearing the quarter marker and could not find a final response.

NIGHT CRY allowed to settle early, raced outside of rivals along the turn, loomed four then five wide into the stretch, took command at the furlong marker, pulled away in the final sixteenth and was geared down late while in hand. RABBLE stalked the early pace three wide, battled into upper stretch then vied for the lead at the furlong grounds, could not match strides with the winner into the final sixteenth and was second best. PRIX pressed the early pace from between runners, took command into the turn and kicked clear at the quarter marker, came under pressure nearing the furlong grounds, yielded to the top pair in the late stages and was clear for third. FORTUNE DREAMS rated off of the early pace, saved ground into the turn then advanced into upper stretch, could not sustain his run to the final sixteenth and weakened late. HEAVENLY CHARM broke a bit slowly, lacked early speed and was not a factor. FACTUALITY showed good early speed, set a contested pace to the turn then chased to upper stretch, could not keep pace to the furlong marker and tired in the stretch drive.

NEUTRAL CAUSE settled off of the early pace, rallied two to three wide and between foes into the stretch, vied between runners into the final sixteenth and was outfinished for the win, while besting the rest. GREY MARKET contested the early pace from the inside, shook free into the turn and held sway to upper stretch, was all out inside of the furlong marker then was overtaken by the top pair into the final sixteenth and held clearly for third. PRINCESS ELANY tracked the early leading pair, chased from the inside into upper stretch and lacked a late response. AIN'T NO OTHER disputed the early pace from outside of GREY MARKET, could not keep pace with that rival nearing the quarter pole then gave way in the stretch.
