JABRAN settled off of the early pace while never far back, saved ground to the quarter marker then mounted an inside rally to upper stretch, dueled with IMTAKINITTOTHEBANK past mid-stretch, took a narrow lead in deep stretch and held off the runner-up in the final strides for a determined win. IMTAKINITTOTHEBANK sent to assume early command, showed good speed while setting the pace off of the rail, met the bid of JABRAN nearing mid-stretch, fought gamely to deep stretch, was outfinished in the final strides and was well clear of the rest for second. SAY IT AIN'T SO chased the decent pace three to four wide nearing the quarter marker, was outkicked in the stretch drive but kept on into in the late stages and got up for third. K W CAPTAIN HOOK settled early, chased four to five wide to upper stretch, needed more in the final sixteenth and just missed for third. CENTRIFUGAL FORCE pressed the decent early pace outside of IMTAKINITTOTHEBANK, battled to upper stretch, was outkicked at the furlong marker then faded in the final stages. CELTIC MISCHIEF allowed to settle, coaxed along three to four wide to the quarter marker, was outrun to upper stretch and lacked the needed late response.

MARKET OF STOCKS prominent away from the start, attended to the moderate pace up the backstretch, took command nearing the quarter marker, kicked clear into the stretch then kept to task under moderate urging into the final sixteenth. CANA GRIS allowed to settle early, angled four wide along the second turn then chased five wide to upper stretch, ran in pursuit of MARKET OF STOCKS into the final furlong, could not muster a final response and held safely for second. LONIE MO off a step slow leaving the start, settled to the first turn, advanced while widest up the backstretch, chased three to four wide into the far turn, was outkicked in the stretch drive and was clear of the rest for third. YEHAWMEMAW settled in the early going, trailed to the far turn, saved ground to upper stretch and passed tiring rivals in the late stages. LITTLE MUSIC sent for the early lead, set a prompted pace up the backstretch, was overtaken nearing the quarter marker then drifted out a bit nearing the top of the lane, could not keep pace to the furlong pole and faded. OCHO'S SECRET rated just off of the early pace, was well placed while saving ground up the backstretch, lost position nearing the quarter marker then tired in the stretch drive.

SKY KEY pressed the decent pace to the far turn, took command and kicked clear nearing the quarter marker, held sway to mid-stretch then drew away under moderate urging in the final sixteenth. NICE SHOT DOUG broke alertly then took back off of the early pace, was well placed while saving ground to the far turn, could not reel in the winner into the stretch drive and was a clear second best. LYLAS LUCKY BOY allowed to settle, made a three wide move approaching the far turn, chased SKY KEY into upper stretch, could not sustain his run into the stretch drive and was clear at the finish for third. EGYPTIAN QUEST settled in the second flight to begin, tracked the decent pace two wide along the backstretch, chased along the far turn, asked for run three wide into the lane and did not rally late. FIXITWITHFORWARD hustled for the early lead, assumed command and set a pressured pace up the backstretch, was overtaken into the far turn and tired in the stretch drive. REDHILL allowed to settle away from the start, lacked early speed and did not factor.

SCIENCE (IRE) prominent away from the start, rated off of the early pace and saved ground to the backstretch, was well placed to the far turn, asked for run to upper stretch and could not find more in the late stages. BULLSEYE BUN settled off of the early pace, swung six wide into upper stretch and did not rally in the late stages. BREAKWATER unhurried to the backstretch, swung seven wide for the stretch drive and could not muster the needed late response. CASANOVA KITTEN tracked the pace three wide to the backstretch, ran in pursuit four wide nearing the quarter marker, lost position into upper stretch and gave way in the drive.
