RIESENBERG tracked the leaders from the inside to the final turn then angled out to two wide to go between horses near the five sixteenths pole to take the lead and drew off in the stretch. MIDNITESTATEOFMIND raced four wide into the first turn then stalked the pace down the backstretch, moved up to engage the leader near the three furlong marker and took a brief lead, kept on to be clearly second best. COACH CAMPBELL raced five wide into the first turn then was allowed to settle down the backstretch and passed tired one in early stretch. EL FRANCO went to the front to set the pace to the final turn but was caught near the three furlong marker and weakened. MR. PETERKIN was always back and never a threat.

DOCTOR NASH was allowed to settle in the early stages while saving ground then slowly moved up to go between horses near the three sixteenths pole, shifted back inside to make a strong rail bid to drive past the leaders in the final sixteenth and was up late for the win. TIMELESS BOUNTY trailed the field to the top of the stretch then angled out to four wide in upper stretch for a late rally but was not enough. INSOLITO rush to a clear lead to the top of the stretch then was headed near the eighth pole, overtaken near the sixteenth pole and outkicked in the final yards. CAPO LUIGI prompted the pace from two wide to the top of the stretch, engaged the leader in early stretch but lacked a response and was outfinished. BANG A RANG raced in the middle of the pack from off the rail then passed tired one on the turn and failed to menace. NON FUNGIBLE raced off the pace to the middle of the turn and gave way.

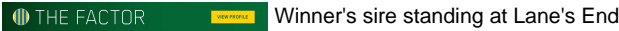

NICO'S DERBY RUN stalked the pace from two wide to the final turn then fell back around the final turn but made a four wide rebid in upper stretch to have his best strides late for the place. LORD RIPLEY was unhurried around the first turn then moved up to go three wide near the half mile marker and was gaining steadily on the leader around the final turn but flattened out. THUBOOT hustled to a clear lead to midway through the final turn then was headed near the quarter pole and tired. KING HAZELTON raced four wide into the first turn then settled off the pace while racing three wide down the backstretch but lacked the late response. MADCAP saved ground to no avail.

PARLAY was hustled along to match strides inside of FACTISIMFLASHY through the final turn then edged away but drifted out near the eighth pole then drifted back in near the sixteenth pole and bumped GREEN LADY twice in the final sixteenth and was denied the win. OUR LAST SONG raced in the middle of the pack while saving ground down the backstretch then moved up from two wide around the turn, angled out to four wide near the eighth pole to make a late charge and just missed. COUNTESS COLETTE trailed the field to the final turn then moved between horses near the three furlong marker, shifted back inside near the eighth pole and was gaining late on the show. MIZ KEETA trailed to the first turn then advanced from two wide through the final turn, tipped out to three wide in upper stretch for a late try and improve position. FACTISIMFLASHY rushed up to early lead, matched strides outside of PARLAY to the top of the stretch before giving way. TIERNEY was allowed to settle into the first turn while saving ground through the turn then tipped out to five wide in upper stretch but failed to menace. LEDGENDARY KITTEN hustled to cut the corner into the first turn and was off the pace down the backstretch then dropped back. PRAISE N GLORY hesitated and hopped at the start spotting the field several length early then was used early to be in the middle of the pack but dropped back into the final turn and was outrun.
