WASABI BEACH broke outward at the start and made light contact with LEMON DROP HERO, had the best speed from the break, established the front end early, kicked clear by a length or two near the three-furlong pole, then responded when set down in upper stretch and held a clear advantage to the wire under steady handling. LEMON DROP HERO took a light bump at the start from WASABI BEACH and was a step or two slow to get into stride, settled three-wide off the pace outside of BUCKEYE MIKE through the early stages, continued that path through the turn, and finished with some run but could not get to the winner. BUCKEYE MIKE was held up early while never far from the front, ran on some in the stretch, but was unable to make up any ground. TAP THE WIND broke well to secure the inside position, stalked WASABI BEACH to the start of the turn, made an early run at that rival but was easily turned back, then did not have the needed response in the late stages.

IBUKI settled inside just off the early leader VOTARY, always traveling well, moved to engage from the half-mile pole, dueled through the turn, then pulled ahead in mid-stretch and widened the margin to the finish. VOTARY took command of the pace early, then dueled with IBUKI through the turn, but could not go on with that rival from mid-stretch, and finished well clear of the next horse. WAVE SKIPPER came away from the gate awkwardly, was devoid of early speed, lost contact with the field, then made a belated run late on the turn and into the stretch to gain third, but was still well behind the top two. CAUSE IMA ROSE was close up to the half-mile pole, then started to lose ground going into the turn and was not a factor in the later stages.

SOCIALBUTTERFLYTAM was coaxed along from the break to keep pace with the forward group, moved up with an inside run through the turn, took advantage of a huge opening on the rail at the top of the stretch to take the lead, and finished well under strong handling to hold safe from a mild threat from a rival on the outside. RUN CAMILA RUN stalked the pace three-wide while behind held up a bit through the backstretch run, was let loose with three furlongs to run, bid three wide for the lead at the top of the stretch, and finished up well but was outkicked by the winner in the final yards. SMART WITH HEART outpaced in the initial stages after a level start, settled at the rear of the main group, came under a drive from the three-furlong pole, was never a threat to the top pair but outfinished the rest to gain third. AADYA mutually bumped with SOPHISTICATED CAT at the break, then was outpaced through the early stages, dropped to last, then ran on some late to pass tired foes in the stretch. CABERNEIGH was hustled to the front from the break, led the way through the turn, then gave way readily in upper stretch. SOPHISTICATED CAT bumped with AADYA at the start, raced close up between horses, gave way approaching the three-furlong pole and had nothing to offer in the stretch.

NICO'S DERBY RUN was unhurried from the start, settled three-wide through the first turn, and was last midway down the backstretch run, and was pushed to make a forward move after passing the half-mile pole, and responded by advancing three-wide to the front through the far turn to get level with the leaders at the quarter pole, took command in mid-stretch, and drew off under strong handling. THUBOOT dueled outside of KING HAZELTON while racing five lengths clear of the rest through the first half-mile, took a brief lead passing the five-sixteenths marker, then battled back when taken on by NICO'S DERBY RUN approaching the quarter pole, then weakened in the final furlong. UTOPIAN TREASURE tracked inside with the second flight well behind the early leaders to the half, saved ground throughout, tipped out to the three-path in the stretch, and was kept to task and able to gain the third prize. THE TOWN TAP settled behind the field down the backstretch, came four-wide into the stretch, finished evenly, and lacked the needed late kick. LAVERNS LAD raced two-deep well behind the pace through the early stages, got floated out to the four or five path on the last bend, then was in tight between horses in upper stretch and lacked a finish. KING HAZELTON dueled inside of THUBOOT while under some restraint, dropped off the pace while trying to get out on the far turn, then had nothing to offer in the stretch.

KICK OUT THE JAMS settled at the back of the main pack through the early stages, was left with a lot to do at the top of the lane, but put in a good rally, was steadily gaining, but ran out of time. KING'S LEGACY settled two to three wide in the middle of the pack, launched a bid from the five-sixteenths marker, was making up good ground in upper stretch, but flattened out last sixteenth. WOODS HOLE got a good position early, just behind the lone pacesetter, made an early try at that one near the halfway point, then could not kick on with that rival through the turn and weakened. HALCYON DAYS bumped with the inside rival at the start, was last into the first turn, trailed the field to the stretch, then oufinished a couple of tired rivals in the late stages. COUNCILWOMAN JILLY broke out and made light contact with

BLOSSOMING at the start, chased three-wide in the second flight to the far turn, then weakened. OUR PRAYER was unhurried from the start, raced far behind the field and was never a factor.

ACE ON THE TURN broke well, avoided trouble to the inside and outside, was sent to get a forward position but was outpaced to the clubhouse turn, settled mid-pack late on that turn, then advanced steadily down the backstretch run to put a head in front at the seven-sixteenths marker, moved aggressively through the far turn to put some distance on the rest, came into the stretch with a clear lead and maintained a clear advantage to the finish. NICE SHOT DOUG hustled from the break, but broke into the path of AMERICA SILVER, ceded the front but secured an inside position, was close up to the far turn, then lost some ground on the leaders late on that turn, but kept to task and outfinished the rest to gain the place, while no real threat to the winner. THEFRONTIERSMAN was sent hard from the break, raced three-wide always close up to the pace, then was outfinished for second. HIGH ENOUGH broke slowly, settled between horses at the back, then started a forward move after passing the five-furong pole, kept to task, but was never a serious threat to hit the board. UNUSUAL ACTIVITY reserved early, saved ground, and mildly improved position after the issue had long been decided up front. AMERICAN SILVER lost the path and took up after the break, was last into the first turn, then advanced closer down the backstretch, launched a bid in earnest from the three-furlong pole, lugged in at the head of the stretch, and flattened out. LYLAS LUCKY BOY raced three-wide mid-pack through the early running, made a brief bid midway through the far turn but could not sustain and was unable to threaten late. EGYPTIAN QUEST broke sharply and outsprinted the field into the first turn to set the early pace, led the way to the far turn, then gave way readily and had nothing left for the stretch run. HECTOR B vied between horses for the early lead for the first half-mile, then steadily retreated and was not a factor in the late stages.
