BEYOND REPROACH went to the lead from the start through 9 fences, could not hold back ON THE COUCH before the final, and was outrun in the stretch for place. TEN BUCKS A GLASS rated early, advanced to keep touch with the leaders after the 5th fence, made a mild bid after the 9th, then ran evenly to the wire. MR CORN raced evenly and never challenged the leaders. JAMESTOWN raced out the back, tired, pulled up before the final and walked off. TEA WITH EDGAR trailed, tired and pulled up before the 7th and walked off.

GRAY'S FABLE stalked the leader, bid at the 9th fence, was unable to hold sway over PLEASANT FANTASY after the 9th, landed awkwardly over the final and held position for place. VERBAL kept pace with the leader, briefly assumed command at the 8th fence, jumped the 9th three abreast with PLEASANT FANTASY and GRAY'S FABLE, then flattened. D'SHINER JEANS trailed and was never a factor, pulled up before the final and walked off. SAINT TEMPLAR ran out the back, gained ground after the 6th, weakened, pulled up before the final and walked off. READY FOR THE LADY kept touch with the leaders through 5 fences, lost ground after the 6th, bid before the 7th, weakened, pulled up before the final and walked off. ANYTIME set the pace through 7 fences, stumbled on landing at the 8th, pulled up, and walked off.

KING OF TSAVO (GB) stalked the leader, assumed command after STARFORCE fell at the 8th fence, held sway over challengers at the final and won driving. ANOINT raced out the back, bid after the 9th fence to quickly gain ground on the outside, challenged KING OF TSAVO (GB) at the final but was outkicked in the stretch. OUTPERFORM rated, trailed midrace, bid after the 9th to gain ground, and rallied in the stretch for show. HOLD HARD (IRE) kept pace with the leaders, bid before the final but flattened in the stretch. ENCOSTA (IRE) kept touch with the leaders, bid before the final, then weakened. ANADOR (FR) raced midpack, bid after the 9th to gain ground, then flattened and had no stretch rally. FOREVER HOPEFUL raced out the back, was never a threat, pulled up before the final, and walked off. BRIGHT EYED EAGLE (IRE) started out the back, steadily gained ground through 7 fences, stumbled over the fallen STARFORCE on landing at the 8th, lost rider, and walked off. STARFORCE went to the early lead, set the pace through 8 fences, fell on landing at the 8th, and walked off.

SWORE pressed the pace through 8 of 10 fences, assumed command after the 8th, dueled with CHORTAL (GB) before the final, and drew away in the stretch. CHORTAL (GB) kept pace with the leaders, dueled with SWORE before the final, but was outpaced in the stretch. COUTACH (GB) started out the back, bid after the 8th to gain ground and found his best stride late. BATMAN GIRAC (FR) trailed the field through 9 fences, mounted a late bid before the final and gained position in the stretch. RAMPOLDI PLAN rated early, made a mild bid before the 7th, hung, then gained ground before the final, and flattened in the stretch. SCOOP THE POT raced midpack through 9 fences, was asked in the final turn but had little response. TWO PAST EIGHT (GB) showed early speed, leading through 6 fences, gave way to SWORE at the 7th and faded.
