PANTHERA was mid field away from the gates, saving ground along the rail, then rallied in the far turn and just held on for second. TRUE MYTH was allowed to settle early on, trailing the field way back, then made a bid into the turn with a a steady gain down the lane. GYPSY WIFE was near the back early on, racing well off the leaders, then offered a mild bid around the turn but it was not enough. ANN ALEE pressed the early pace, drifted out in the stretch drive and dropped back. DERRYGOOLIN chased the field, near the front runners early, racing wide but faded in the stretch drive.

MIA BABY stalked the early pace from the outside, then gained command at the head of the lane, having continued pressure by the early leader, SHARP ATTITUDE, down the lane, but prevailing at the wire with a driving finish. SHARP ATTITUDE made the lead early on, racing along the inside, but gave way grudgingly coming into the stretch drive and hung on for a game second. BIRDIE BE GONE was near the leaders early, then dropped back a around the turn, saving ground, offered a bid at the head of the lane but hung a bit late. PETIT JEAN trailed the field away from the gate, offered a middle move around the turn but flattened out in deep stretch. IN THE VAULT broke sharply, then pressed the pace down the backstretch but faded in the turn.

TAP THE KID stalked the pace from the outside, down the backstretch, then rallied in the stretch drive, just getting up for second but was no match for the winner. MORE MONEY MO was mid field early on, racing along the inside, then closed mildly down the lane, just missing second. TARPS STORM trailed the field early, then started a steady gain down the backstretch, but it was too little too late. THE MAN THE MYTH made the lead early but was overtaken at the half, but hung on pressuring the leader until the middle of the far turn and then gave way in the stretch drive. DAWKINS was near the back early, racing evenly throughout and never fired. ROWAN AUGUST showed no early foot away from there, then made a middle move at the half but faded in the far turn. FOLLOW MY HEINEKEN was mid pack during the early going, racing along the inside, but dropped back early.
