RAETASTIC was clear early, set the pace, responded when challenged on the turn, dueled through the stretch and was outfinished in a good effort. HONEYCRISP was never far off the pace, saved ground, angled out on the turn, bid six wide, closed steadily and gained late to earn show. ZANZORA moved up on the backstretch to press the pace, challenged between horses on the turn, dropped back, leveled off and faded through the stretch. EXQUISITE CANDY stumbled at the start, was checked early, raced in the back in an even effort and was outrun.

EIGHTYSIXCHEVY led early, dropped back to stalk the pace, rallied into the turn, assumed command, drew off for a clear lead and held off the late charge of WITHOUT EQUAL to just last at the wire. WITHOUT EQUAL was never far off the pace, advanced on the turn, bid four wide at the top of the stretch, found his best stride late and was gaining fast. AMBIGUOUS was slow early, went three wide entering the stretch and offered a mild bid to be along for show. WHITING FIELD was a bit crowded at the start, saved ground to the upper stretch, angled out and failed to respond. GIANNO set the pace to the turn, tired and gave way. CANDY'S CHROME bobbled and came out at the start, trailed the field, swung wide entering the stretch and lacked a bid.

SHIP IT RED stalked the pace, rallied four wide into the stretch, bid willingly to duel and drew off near the sixteenth pole. PARETO'S PRINCIPLE set the pace, responded to duel, yielded near the sixteenth pole and held for place. TEST PILOT stalked the pace along the inside, bid along the rail on the turn to contend, hung late and was outfinished for second. FAMILY TRADITION was void of early speed, put in a steady effort to improve his position and was not a threat. JOHNNY UP raced mid pack, lacked a stretch response and dropped back. MONGOLIAN MOON was taken outside early, trailed the field, was not urged and showed little. The rider of PARETO'S PRINCIPLE claimed foul against the rider of SHIP IT RED for alleged interference in late stretch. No change was made.
