THE SCENT chased the leader up the backstretch, swung out to the five path coming around the turn, dueled in upper stretch and edged clear. CHIRAG led the way through the opening quarter, came around the turn in the four path, drifted out while dueled in upper stretch and was caught late. LITTLE TROUBLE was away from the gate slowly, moved up to race in the middle of the pack on the outside early, continued around the bend in the two path, began a bid entering the stretch and improved position. ORO raced in the middle of the pack on the inside up the backstretch, saved ground around the bend and showed no kick. COACH SAM P raced off the pace on the outside up the backstretch, navigated the turn from the three path and was empty in the lane. WORK BOOTS broke through the gate prior to the race but was held in place by his handler, raced off the pace on the inside through the early going, saved ground around the turn and made no bid.

KENNEBEC saved ground in the middle of the pack through the opening half mile, continued to save ground around the second bend, switched outside to began a bid in upper stretch and improved position from there. LLOYDS LOGIC raced in the two path around the first turn, chased the leader up the backstretch, challenged from the three path around the far turn and was outkicked in the lane but kept on to the wire. FLINT STROLL saved ground early, raced off the pace up the backstretch, continued to save ground around the far bend and made no bid. COFFEE CALIENTE raced in the three path around the first turn, settled in the middle of the pack on the outside for the run up the backstretch, navigated the far bend from the two path and weakened in the stretch.
