THUNDER KIN dueled on the inside up the backstretch, continued around the turn in the two path and held clear to the finish. BLUES CROSS trailed the field early, swung out to the four path to began a bid passing the quarter pole and gained ground late. PEARL BUTTON dueled on the outside up the backstretch, navigated the bend from the three path and could not go with the leader in the stretch but chased on to the wire. EXTRA INDY raced off the pace through the opening stages, saved ground around the turn and showed no kick. HOLY IMAGE raced in the middle of the pack on the inside up the backstretch, continued around the turn in the two path and made no bid. NOT A WORD raced in the middle of the pack on the outside up the backstretch, swung out to the five path coming around the bend and faded from there. MAGENS BAY chased the leader through the early going, came around the bend in the four path and tired in the stretch, easing across the wire.
