MR INSENSITIVE ducked in at the start but avoided any contact, settled mid-pack along the rail, responded when asked to go on with three furlongs to run, swung four wide into the stretch, took over the lead with a sixteenth to run, and went clear, easily holding off a fast closing rival on the outside. SCORE MCCOY steadied at the start then was void of speed, was a distant trailer to the far turn, then produced a furious rally saving ground through the far turn and kept on through the stretch to get up into the second spot in the last jumps. STAR MISSION bobbled at the start, then pressed the pace three-wide through the early stages, launched a bid after passing the three-furlong pole, finished well but was outkicked in the final yards. CATRICK showed the way with a clear advantage early, tried to kick away late on the far turn, came into the stretch with a clear lead but could not last and weakened in the final furlong. RUN BRYCE RUN lacked any early initiative, trailed far behind for the first half-mile, started a run from the seven-sixteenths marker, circled the field through the far turn, and finished up well but was not doing enough late to threaten. JET STREAM tracked two-wide with the second flight, moved up going into the far turn and finished evenly without menacing. WOCKA WOCKA got bumped after the break, then was hard to place in the early running, settled well behind the pace, then lacked a rally. BOSS DOWN broke outward at the start, bothering SCORE MCCOY, then was hustled from the break, then chose not to contest the early pace, moved up to put some pressure on the leader heading into the far turn, came under a stiff drive approaching the three-furlong pole, and tired in the stretch.

SONIC SPEED settled at the back early on after a bit of a tardy start, got over to the rail and steadily advanced down the backstretch, waited for room through the far turn, then found the path blocked turning into the stretch, deftly angled out to the five-path in upper stretch, then surged through the final furlong to be along in time. TOUCH OF ZEN was allowed to settle near the back early, took up sharply in traffic going into the far turn, then swung to the outside and launched a five-wide rally down the stretch, finished up well despite flopping leads, but could not get to the winner. WODETON (FR) pulled to be three-wide just off the early leaders going through the first turn, tracked a few lengths back down the backstretch, then launched a bid midway on the far turn, pulled even with the leaders in upper stretch, finished well but was outkicked late by the top pair. AFJAN stalked the early pace from the rail, waited for room through the far turn, tried to split horses in upper stretch, lost the path, then angled to the rail, finished up well up the rail but was not quite good enough. CAUGHT OFF GUARD showed good early speed, pressed two-wide to the far turn, ramped up the pressure leaving the quarter pole, put a head in front briefly at the head of the stretch, fought on gamely in the stretch battle but was outfinished in the late stages. FOUND JORDAN was throttled back by the rider after the start, then became rank turning on to the main course, settled down and was last through the first turn, then advanced going into the last turn, made a wide sweeping move through the far turn, was in contention turning for home four wide, but was outfinished. PAPA RIZZO showed good speed from the break, made the rail and the lead with the rider trying to temper the pace, led the way into the far turn but lacked a response.

HARD LOVE was off a step slow then moved over to the rail when clear, settled near the back of the main pack, was patiently ridden two-wide through the far turn, finished willingly when presented with a huge opening in mid-stretch, and surged past a stubborn HEAT N REHEAT in deep stretch to prevail. HEAT N REHEAT tracked inside with the third flight, well off the pace, moved up on the far turn, waited for some room approaching the stretch, cut the corner to get first run into the stretch, finished well, led late, but was outkicked in the final yards by the winner. PEPPER JACK was forwardly placed on the rail, tipped out to the two path turning into the stretch, finished well, but came up short. TOMA TODO went quickly to the front, showed the way with a clear advantage to the half, turned back a couple of challengers early on the far turn, went clear again into the stretch, but was unable to last. ITS A BOY raced in the middle of the pack in cover through the first half mile, continued to race mid-pack even as the field bunched up going into the far turn, then put forth an even finish in the stretch, holding position but unable to threaten for the win. MARK IN GREELEY was the distant trailer to the turn and passed tiring rivals in the lane, but was not able to improve beyond that. CRAFTY KING was allowed to settle from the break, went three-wide through the clubhouse turn, moved up as the field bunched up going into the far turn, was unable to make any headway, then faltered in the stretch. OH GREAT (IRE) was never far back, racing two to three wide through the early stages, made an early run at the leader early on the far turn, but weakened near the quarter pole and had little left for the stretch run.

MAXCHERO broke best, led under some restraint to the turn, then opened up to be four lengths clear turning for home, drifted out to the center of the course racing on the left lead, but had a large enough lead to hold on to the finish. PAW ALLEN stumbled coming out of the gate, tracked three-wide down the backstretch, then came under a ride from the three-furlong pole, hooked up with MOR TIGER PAW in a spirited battle for the second spot and got a favorable nod at the line. MOR TIGER PAW settled mid-pack, not far back through the early running, dueled with PAW ALLEN down the stretch for second, but came up short at the wire. PASTOR DAVE presssed the early pace of MAXCHERO from the inside, was unable to go on with that one from the quarter pole then faltered in mid-stretch. CAN'T KNOW was far back in the early stages and only barely managed to outfinish a pair of tiring rivals. GOOD GRIEF CLAUDE was outrun early, then lugged out in upper stretch. MY BOY BOMBER was close up three-wide to the turn, struggled to keep up, then had nothing to offer in the stretch.
