NANCY'S SHAWL was hustled for speed, set the early pace between horses, continued to take mild pressure from RHYTHM READY while racing in the two path on the turn, began to clear the field from the quarter pole, responded to a brief drive in upper stretch, opened up an insurmountable lead and was allowed to cruise home late. HEAVENLY DESTINY broke sharply but settled back to chase four wide, was pushed along in the four path and made mild improvement past the five sixteenths, swung into the lane in the five path, proved no match for NANCY'S SHAWL, but chased on to prove best of the rest. INSTANT LOVE was positioned five wide near the rear early, switched inward approaching the far turn, was pushed along in the two path on the bend and took closer order, was driven inside foes into upper stretch, could not match NANCY'S SHAWL, vied inside of HEAVENLY DESTINY for place but was outgamed. RHYTHM READY raced keenly early and attended the pace three wide, continued to prompt the pacesetter into the turn while positioned in the three path, could not go with the leader from near the quarter, was driven between foes into the stretch and flattened in the final furlong. PROMISES settled at the rear early while positioned six wide, made a brief bid in the five path from near the three eighths, was driven into the lane in the six path and came up empty. MARIAROSADELASERDA attended the pace inside of NANCY'S SHAWL, began to flatten along the rail from the half mile mark, and had no further response when driven into the lane.

RHYME AWAY was nudged to the early lead, inched clear from the nine sixteenths racing well within herself, set the pace in the two path on the turn, responded when pushed along into upper stretch, and continued to run on an insurmountable lead while mostly hand ridden, feeling the crop just once approaching the sixteenth pole. MINNY FOR THE MAX was bumped by CHARLIES MINT in the opening strides in the chain reaction from HEAVENSGOLDENGIFT breaking outward, chased toward the rear early outside DERBY DAY ROSE, bid in the three path between horses from near the furlong pole, had the leader in range until the quarter pole, proved no match for RHYME AWAY into the lane but chased on with good interest under a drive to prove clearly second best. CHARLIES MINT broke sharply despite being bumped between horses in the opening strides due to HEAVENSGOLDENGIFT breaking outward, stalked the leader early, raced three wide in the tracking flight into the turn, chased in the four path around the turn, came two wide into upper stretch, could not keep up with the leading pair in the lane, greenly drifted out and in while being driven in the lane but nonetheless held the show. HEAVENSGOLDENGIFT broke outward bumping CHARLIES MINT in the opening strides, soon trailed, continued to trail while urged in the two to three path on the turn, swung into the lane in the six path for the drive, and drove past a tiring horse late. DERBY DAY ROSE tracked the leading pair early, raced into the turn at the inside of the tracking flight, saved ground on the turn but was still no match for the leading pair past the three eighths, was driven along the rail in upper stretch and weakened.

ERIKA MARIE broke toward the rear but was nudged to track the pace between horses, tracked behind the leader along the inside into the turn, was pushed along past the five sixteenths and switched outside of ONE MOR ROSE, rallied three wide in upper stretch, loomed midstretch, sustained her bid under a drive and got up inside the sixteenth pole. ONE MOR ROSE jumped to the lead, took mild prompting from FROSTED PEACH early, led in the two path on the turn, was engaged by COCONITE to the outside past the three eighths, shook that foe off near the half, clung to the lead under a drive from upper stretch, but could not hold off ERIKA MARIE past the sixteenth. AUNT GWEN'S broke slowly and trailed early, raced three wide into the turn, bid four wide from near the five sixteenths, went to a drive three wide in upper stretch, continued to run on with interest under a drive in the lane and got up for the show past the sixteenth mark. ADRIENNE'S BALBOA settled near the rear, raced in the three and then two path on the turn and began to improve near the five sixteenths, was driven inside into the lane and loomed in upper stretch, but weakened in the final furlong. FROSTED PEACH tracked outside the pacesetter early, began to flatten out between horses into the turn, raced into the lane between horses in the rear flight, chased under a drive in the lane and had no kick. MAY SURPRISE tracked the leading pair early, was wrangled back behind horses approaching the turn and relegated to the rear, saved ground around the turn, was driven in upper stretch at the inside of the rear flight and came up empty. COCONITE raced keenly four to five wide on the backstretch, bid in the five path approaching the three eighths, came up flat from the quarter pole, raced into the lane in the six path and had no more for the drive.

CUPIDS CRUSH raced under a hold early after jumping to an uncontested lead, cleared off a few lengths down the backstretch, saved ground around the far turn, raced clear into the stretch, opened up a few more lengths on the field, and was allowed to stroll home easily after her rider looked back twice near the furlong mark and saw no looming challenge. VINTAGE PORT tracked the pacesetter early, chased the leader down the backstretch, took closer order approaching the far turn, tracked the leader in the two to three path around the far turn, proved no match for the pacesetter into the lane under a drive inside, but found enough under a drive to keep on for the place. FLATTER ME BILLY was taken to the rear early while racing keenly, raced two wide in the rear flight around the far turn, continued at the rear down the back straight, raced two wide on the far turn in the rear flight, vied outside of GO K J GO under a drive in the lane and narrowly got up for show. GO K J GO broke outward, raced at the inside of the rear flight into the first turn, chased toward the rear down the back straight, saved ground around the far turn, was urged near the three eighths but could not muster enough kick to threaten the top pair, battled inside of FLATTER ME BILLY under a drive down the lane for show and was outfinished.

SUMMER WINNER led three wide early, was headed by THUNDERS ROCKNROLL to her inside into the turn and pressed the pace from there, reengaged outside that foe near the five sixteenths, dueled into upper stretch, took a narrow lead near the furlong mark and edged clear under a drive despite drifting out. THUNDERS ROCKNROLL broke well but attended the pace inside the leading pair early, went keenly to take a narrow lead inside past the half, set the pace into the turn inside of SUMMER WINTER, was reengaged by that foe near the five sixteenths and vied inside into upper stretch under a drive, could not find enough to keep her at bay past the half but narrowly held the place. MITOLE PRINCESS tracked the leading trio early, was pushed along approaching the three eighths and began to improve three wide, went to a drive in upper stretch, drifted out but nonetheless continued to rally and just missed the place. HEAVENLY CAPTIVE settled at the rear early, was pushed for a bid past the seven sixteenths and briefly improved between horses, but chased on only mildly in the lane. CARSON BAY pressed the pace between horses early, was outkicked into the turn by SUMMER WINNER and THUNDERS ROCKNROLL, flattened inside around the turn, was driven inside into upper stretch and proved empty.
