SAVANNAMARIE transferred contact from an outer rival to an inner foe leaving the gate, laid off of the pace while getting floated to the five path by LASERJET into the first turn, tucked to the inside around that bend before being brushed to tight rail quarters by the aforementioned foe into the backstretch, launched progress three wide into the far turn, ranged up to bid outside of the leaders entering the lane and drove clear leaving upper stretch. NEVER SWAY prompted four to two path, vied around the turn, forged an advantage in upper stretch and inched clear in the final furlong. AWESOME ANNMARIE broke a step slow, tracked along the inside before steadying subtly behind a rival reaching the five furlong pole, moved two wide and between foes with a half mile to go, pursued turning for home, took aim behind the new leader from the three to four path in upper stretch, maintained striking range in the final furlong, but was turned away passing the sixteenth pole and saved place from an inner counterpart. FARM TEAM laid off of the pace in the two path, launched a rally in the three path and between horses approaching the lane, split the leaders in the final furlong and edged past late. TIZ MY HERO stalked three wide, bid turning for home, gained an advantage in the four path in upper stretch but was bested by an inner bidder in the final sixteenth. BATTER UP had his head turned slightly as the gates sprung and broke slow, pursued from midpack, crept closer

three to four wide and between horses into and around the turn, tipped to take aim outside of the new leader and from the five path entering upper stretch, but only managed to chase evenly and gained show. PACE YOURSELF set the pace along the inside, met a pair of outer challenges turning for home, got headed by his widest challenger in upper stretch and gave way. RAISING KANE splayed his feet and brushed the gate at the start, shifted ground outwardly early on, tracked from midpack two wide and between horses, chased into the lane, shifted outwardly in midstretch and stayed on one paced. REDACTED vied for the lead with an outer rival shook clear in upper stretch and held sway safely. MISTER BANDERAS pursued off of the pace in the four path and between horses, shifted out to the six path into the lane, rallied to reach place in the final sixteenth and held that position while narrowing the leader's margin late. DIXIE DEVIL broke a step slow, trailed in the three path, swung out to the eight path into upper stretch, rallied to issue a late bid for place while closing in on the leader but was denied that position. TAP ME A SONG vied for the lead two wide and outside of the eventual winner, proved no match in upper stretch and gave way.
